4. Industrial sand mine permitting – Update

5. Wetland Mitigation - Discuss

Jon spoke on wetland mitigation and has set up a meeting with Josh Peterson from parks and forestry to discuss the program, options, and what land is available. Jon will be looking at all four options below to progress forward:
