1. Call meeting to order

Chairman Henning called the meeting to order at 6:15 a.m.

2. Confirmation of meeting notice - Review

Meeting notice confirmed.

3. November 19th, 2015 Committee Minutes - Review/Discuss/Act

Motion: Supervisor Forsythe moved to approve minutes. Motion carried 5-0

4. Town of Drammen Bridge Aid Petition – Discuss/Act

Jon Johnson spoke on Bridge Aid forms and reviewed the Town of Drammen's Petition. Motion: Supervisor Forsythe moved to approve petition. Motion carried 5-0

5. Equipment financing – Update/Act

Jon Johnson presented financial cost data concerning purchasing vs leasing road fleet (trucks), motor grader, and asphalt paver to address aging fleet. Three options were discussed: purchasing outright, financing with no residual, financing with 90k residual. With financing option, there is possibility of warranty work being performed in house. Leasing options were discussed with focus on turnover rate and comparing labor/parts costs. Motion: Supervisor Clark moved to go to fiancé committee for approval for additional borrowing. Motion carried 5-0

6. Industrial sand mine permitting – Update

Hi-Crush is applying for 40 additional acres in the town of Bridge Creek. No updates from Hi-Crush currently to the Highway department.

7. Wetland Mitigation - Discuss

Jon spoke with Josh Peterson from Parks & Forestry concerning possible areas within Eau Claire County that would be suitable for wetland creation. Jon also spoke with the Highway Commissioner from Jackson County concerning a possible joint partnership mitigation bank.

Glory Adams commented on a possible location for wetland mitigation between Augusta and Fairchild. She also voiced concern on regulations put forth when culverts are initially installed are biding.

- Completed field inspection and pacer ratios. Preliminary analysis shows improvement of approximately 10% on rating due to maintenance and resurfacing.
- Interim bridge inspections completed.
- Next years CIP list will be updated in spring 2016.
