### Call to Order

Chair Leary called the meeting to order at 5:43 PM.

### Review / Approval of Committee Minutes / May 4, 2016

Motion by Supervisor Bates to approve the minutes as distributed. Motion carried 4-0.

### Review Bills / Discussion / April 2016

The bills were reviewed.

### **Public Input**

Members of the public included 83 youth campers and 21 youth counselors who shared their favorite parts of camp and skills gained through camp participation.

### Youth in Governance / Discussion

Sara Novotny reported that Alex Braaten, the 2015-2016 youth participant, is to be recognized at the August County Board meeting. She will contact Keith Zehms to determine how to move forward on that recognition. Resolution for YIG noted that the program states that the program must be evaluated for future continuation. Discussion included adding Parks and Forest Committee to the possible committees youth could participate on, and committee members would be willing to contact and promote the experience to interested incoming juniors. Will report in July.

### **Update on WACEC State Conference / Discussion**

June 20-21, 2016 at the Jefferson Street Inn in Wausau. Supervisors Bates, Schraufnagel, DeLuka, and Leary will be in attendance. Discussion at conference to include giving counties options on what positions they would support keeping within the county. Will report in July.

### Update on *nEXT Generation* Model and Hub Situation / Discussion – Action

No county board members have been placed on committees at this time, but will be in near future. Updated timeline states changes won't be occurring until 2017 at the earliest, as discussion on plans is evolving and groups are still being assigned. An effort is being made to include more county partner input. Faculty Senate for UW-Extension voted on seniority in the event of a program discontinuation.

### 4-H Youth Development Program Update / Discussion – Action

Sara Novotny shared updates on the growing camp program. Camp is a partnership between Eau Claire and Dunn Counties; gives more options for cross-county programming, new counseling staff, and more campers. All beds at the camp facility were full for the four day, three night camp. Counselors receive over eight hours of training and plan camp, including creating lesson plans that outline what they teach and evaluate each program. Data accumulated over four years of camp states that campers gain teamwork, communication, and decision-making skills at camp and counselors learn leadership and responsibility, among other skills.

### **Scheduling of Future Meetings / Agenda Items**

The next meeting is scheduled for July 27 at 5:15pm at the Eau Claire County Fair at the Eau Claire County Expo Center Building E. Agenda items include updates on Youth In Governance, WACEC, and nEXT Generation, an educator report from the Agriculture Agent Mark Hagedorn, greenhouse updates, and preliminary budget updates.

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- APPROVING EXTENSION OF THE YOUTH IN GOVERNANCE PROGRAM FOR THE COMMITTEES ON UW-EXTENSION EDUCATION, JUDICIARY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AND EXPANDING THE PROGRAM TO INCLUDE THE PARKS AND FOREST COMMITTEE; AUTHORIZING THE COMMITTEE ON UW-EXTENSION EDUCATION TO ANNUALLY REVIEW THE PROGRAM AND DETERMINE WHETHER IT SHOULD BE CONTINUED -

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2015 the Eau Claire County Board adopted Resolution, Enrolled No. R158-082 which approved a pilot Youth and Governance Program for the committees of UW Extension Education and Judiciary and Law Enforcement for September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the committee on UW Extension Education has reviewed the program and recommends continuing it and expanding it to include the committee on Parks and Forest; and

WHEREAS, the committee recommends that the program be continued as set forth in Resolution No. R158-082 with an annual review in August by the Committee on UW-Extension Education and submittal of a report to the county board.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eau Claire County Board of Supervisors that it approves an extension of the Youth in Governance Program involving youth serving with the UW-Extension Education, Judiciary and Law Enforcement and Parks and Forest committees beginning September 1, 2016.

BE IT FURTHE RESOLVED that the committee on UW-Extension Education is authorized to annually review the program in August to determine whether it should be continued, which committees should be involved and to submit a report with its findings to the county board.

### **FACT SHEET**

### **TO FILE NO. 16-17/026**

YIG incorporates youth involvement in county government, giving youth the opportunity to learn about local government and civic engagement while developing life skills through hands on learning. This opportunity for youth is offered through a partnership with the Eau Claire County Board of Supervisors and the UW-Extension Eau Claire County Office, specifically through 4-H Youth Development.

In the second year, four youth will be selected through an application process and will be appointed to the UW-Extension Education Committee, Parks and Forest Committee, or the Judiciary and Law Enforcement Committee. Youth will represent other Eau Claire County youth on these committees by attending meetings, staying current on issues facing the county, and seeking input from their peers. Youth will vote prior to board members (votes not to be counted) and will participate in discussion on agenda items. Youth are not allowed in closed session and will not receive per diem payments.

To qualify, youth must be high school sophomores or juniors in any Eau Claire County school and have a GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale. They must be an Eau Claire County resident and have the ability to attend monthly committee meetings and additional committee meetings as needed. They will serve a one year term (Sept 1, 2016-August 31, 2017). They will complete an application and interview process and if selected, will work with an appointed mentor from the County Board or community to assist in the process.

According to reports from Kenosha County, youth gain valuable life skills, including the ability to see issues from multiple perspectives and learning to communicate clearly and confidently while becoming a local resource in their county. They will learn to share new ideas with others and become more comfortable in decision making while developing a feel of involvement the community. They will develop life skills that will serve them far into their future, no matter what career path they choose.

There will be no fiscal impact on the 2016 budget.
