Jon Johnson presented a cost analysis of a Reclaimer which can perform both reclamation and stabilization. Jon presented both a 10 year life analysis of new unit vs a 6 year life of a used unit utilized on a 20 mile per year average for both processes. Jon spoke of benefits including:

- Innovative procedure that would provide greater results per dollar spent
- Would provide a slightly longer life expectancy for the road
- Could be rented to other counties
- Could be used to contract with townships
- Recommendation by Highway committee to have Jon present to finance
- Motion by Chairman Henning to add action to discussion items on future agendas. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Supervisor Forsythe. Motion carried 4-0

Commissioner Jon Johnson spoke on the following:
