# Review of County Administrator 2017 Budget Recommendations / by: Kathryn Schauf, County Administrator / Discussion

A budget overview was provided by Kathryn Schauf, County Administrator. According to Schauf, this budget sets us up for future years. In some areas, expenses have been moved from capital to the operating levy.

#### Review of Budget Wrap Up Session Elements / Discussion - Action

Fiscal Risk Areas: added money to contingency (total of \$300,000). Nothing stands out as a red flag.

County Revenues: Sales tax projected at \$9,600,000. Timber is flat and is built in the Parks & Forest budget.

<u>Departmental Review</u>: Remove senior center funding from ADRC budget; increase senior center funding in general fund by same. Briefly reviewed CCS and that experience in other counties is solid.

<u>Community Agency Review</u>: Money for Economic Development Corporation (EDC) was moved to levy. On a motion by Supervisor Conlin, funding to continue on levy for Citizens Employment & Training in 2017; then put them on notice for year 2018 that funds will be reviewed. Motion carried. It was also suggested that in the future, that the committee look at the methodology as to how/why we fund outside organizations.

Capital/Debt Service: Committee reviewed recommendations by County Administrator.

Fund Balance: Finance Director, Scott Rasmussen, provided an overview.

<u>Budget Amendments & Handling:</u> Budget amendment form will be provided to county board members and department heads. Deadline to return to County Administrator is November 1, 2016.

#### User Fees / Review / Discussion - Action

- Review of Psychiatrist and Psychologist Fees / Code Amendment
   Corporation Counsel will draft an ordinance reflecting new fees for 2017. Fees were incorporated in the 2017 circuit court budget.
- Ordinance Establishing Fees in Various Departments
   Not applicable no fee increases in 2017.

Budget Book Format – same as 2016

# <u>Final Recommendations on the 2017 County Budget and Tax Levy to the County Board / Discussion – Action</u>

Recommended levy is \$29,015,659; levy rate will increase from \$3.972 to \$4.020 (change of .048)

Motion by Supervisor Smiar to establish \$29,015,659 as the tax levy for 2017. Motion carried and was unanimous.
