



# **REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OF THE TOWN BOARD – January 25, 2018**

The Regular Meeting of the Town Board was called to order by Chairman Meyer at 6:30 p.m.

Roll Call/Quorum Call of the Board: Chairman Meyer, Supervisor Schnell, Supervisor Anderson, Clerk Traczek, Maintenance-Sam Pettis, and three residents were present.

Chairman Meyer verified that the meeting had been posted, and the agenda would stand as read.

Motion by Supervisor Schnell and seconded by Chairman Meyer to approve the minutes from the December 21, 2017 board meeting. Motion carried. (The public was provided copies of the minutes.)

Chairman Meyer made the motion to approve the treasurer's report, and it was seconded by Supervisor Anderson. Motion carried. (The public was provided a copy of the report.)

A motion to approve the bills for payment was made by Supervisor Schnell and seconded by Chairman Meyer. Motion carried.

Motion by Chairman Meyer and seconded by Supervisor Schnell to approve the transfer of \$24,000.00 from MMBA #1 to pay the bills. Motion carried.

Fire Department Report-Supervisor Anderson reported that there were no calls in the TOF since November. The switch has been made to natural gas, and the LP tanks are full for back-up. (A written report was received from the FFPD.)

Fairchild Public Library Report-Rozanne Traczek once again noted that the roofing is completed, but the soffas and facias will be addressed by Bertrang Roofing in the spring. A big weeding job was done with the completed inventory, and many books in good condition are for sale in the back room of the library for a free will offering. Otherwise, they will be on the big book sales next October during the Falling Leaves Art Tour. Programs running at the library are: Play Pals for preschoolers every first and third Thursday of the month at 10:00 A.M, the after school study/reading time every Tues. and Thurs. from 4-5:30 P.M, and the GED HSED Program and adult education on Wednesdays from 3-6:30 P.M. (A short discussion occurred concerning what computer courses are offered at the library, senior centers, and CVTC.) (A written report was given to the public)

Eau Claire County Sheriff's Dept.-No one attended.

U.S. Silica-No one attended.

Motion by Chairman Meyer and seconded by Supervisor Schnell to adopt the maintenance schedule report. Motion carried. Supervisor Schnell commented on the form being completed monthly.

Discussion followed on building notification parameters. Chairman Meyer asked the board to consider some of the following questions: What size of building was intended when the form was set up? How big or small should the building be for the notification form? References were made to some of the Eau Claire County building permit requirements and portables being exempt. Are we going by county specifications? Supervisor Schnell suggested that the chair meet with the assessor concerning this matter.

Public Comments: Don Curtis asked questions: What is the object of the board digging into what was referenced on item #13? (Building notification parameters) Is this an endeavor to possibly lead to what Bridge Creek does? How does the assessor find out; does he go to the county for information? How are you going to enforce any of this? Chairman Meyer and Supervisor Schnell gave comments: What would be most useful to the assessor for information from us? Consider what is most cost effective. Ask the assessor about other towns, what they are doing, and how they enforce what they do. Don Curtis also asked: Why no maintenance report? Chairman Meyer explained that this was due to the discussions being held on the maintenance schedule and adopting it. Once the maintenance schedule is adopted, it can be used for the maintenance report at the monthly meetings.

Correspondence: (1) Chairman Meyer was unable to attend the sand mining meeting but has requested information from the session. (2) No correspondence has come from Scott Construction since payment of the last bill. (3) Letters will be mailed to certain residents concerning the ATV Route changes. The application has been filed, but a log must be kept of any residents' comments or questions who receive the letter concerning the matter. The filing cost of \$35.00 will be requested from the ATV Club. (4) Registrations for the WAPA free workshop have been received. Sam Pettis and Dick Jinkerson will be registered for it.

The next board meeting was set for February 15, 2018 at 6:30 p.m.

Motion by Supervisor Schnell and seconded by Supervisor Anderson to adjourn. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 7:38 P.M.



### **REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OF THE TOWN BOARD – February 15, 2018**

The Regular Meeting of the Town Board was called to order by Chairman Meyer at 6:30 p.m.

Roll Call/Quorum Call of the Board: Chairman Meyer, Supervisor Schnell, Supervisor Anderson, Clerk Traczek, Treasurer Eisberner, and five residents were present.

Chairman Meyer verified that the meeting had been posted, and the agenda would stand as read.

Motion by Supervisor Schnell and seconded by Chairman Meyer to approve the minutes from the January 25, 2018 board meeting. Motion carried. (The public was provided copies of the minutes.)

Chairman Meyer made the motion to approve the treasurer's report, and it was seconded by Supervisor Anderson. Motion carried. (The public was provided a copy of the report.)

A motion to approve the bills for payment was made by Supervisor Schnell and seconded by Chairman Meyer. Motion carried.

Motion by Supervisor Schnell and seconded by Supervisor Anderson to approve the transfer of \$237,000.00 from MMBA #1 to pay the bills. Motion carried. (This included the tax settlement payments to the county, school districts, and CVTC)

Fire Department Report-Supervisor Anderson had already given the report from the last meeting. (Written minutes and reports were received from the FFPD for the board)

Fairchild Public Library Report-Bertrang Roofing will soon begin the work on the facias and soffas. The board will be discussing covering the cost of the back step roof area that was not included on the insurance coverage. Past donations, that we greatly appreciated, will be covering the cost of this work to be done. Discussion is ongoing about having an open house in partnership with the FFPD and when the new community center is completed. Members of the board plan on attending the community meeting at the Fire Dept. Bldg. on March 1<sup>st</sup> at 7:00 P.M. United Way had its third coffee chat with parents at the Play Pals Program this past week, and the three that they held were successful with excellent attendance. This program for preschoolers continues to have good attendance and is held the first and third Thursday of each month at the library from 10:00 to 11:15. The annual report has been completed for the DPI and approved by IFLS. Rozanne will be going through the report with the FPL board at their meeting on Feb. 21<sup>st</sup>. (A written report was given to the public.)

Eau Claire County Sheriff's Dept.-No one attended.

U.S. Silica-No one attended.

Maintenance Report: Sanding and plowing has been occurring. The blades have been changed on the equipment, leaks, hydraulic hoses have been checked, and a hose has been replaced on the diesel tank. The monthly maintenance forms approved by the board last month have been examined by Chairman Meyer and Supervisor Schnell with additional comments that they will address with the maintenance department concerning numbers on bolts and the Ford. It was suggested that the maintenance reports be kept in a binder by the maintenance dept. The clerk is receiving the reports to file monthly.

Discussion followed on building notification parameters. Chairman Meyer has been in contact with the assessor. The assessor does go to the county and regularly checks the building permits online that are reported. The assessor also told the chair that our township is better than many for permits being recorded in a timely manner. He suggested the notification forms go down to the size of a garage or hunting cabin, portable structures don't count, any additions on pole buildings, and barns should be noted. Chairman Meyer added: Maintenance workers are probably your best eyes and ears with the board doing a follow-up, do another assessor term, and see if it's adequate. The county confirms that our assessor checks with them. Supervisor Schnell stated that it may be a good idea to check with the TOB. Chairman Meyer offered to check with Chairman Jeff Gerike, TOB, to see how they're doing, and Supervisor Schnell would check with the constable for the TOB.

Public Comments: (1) Don Curtis made comments in regard to the building notifications and county permits for the TOF and offered to bring information to the chair and the board concerning buildings. (2) James Engel from the Town of Ludington was allowed to speak, providing a handout to the public and the board, and is running for the Eau Claire County Board. (3) Don Curtis inquired about the board changing their meeting night so that he could attend the TOF board meeting which is the same night as the TOF meeting. Chairman Meyer explained why certain other nights did not work out with other chair and board commitments involved. James Engel also added that he attended various other town meetings, and often many of them have their meetings the same nights as others.

Correspondence: (1) Chairman Meyer gave an update on the ATV Trail, and one positive comment has been received in favor of it from the required mailings that were sent out by the TOF. (2) The Sand Mining workshop is available online from the Minoqua meeting that he was unable to attend. (3) The TOF board has been invited to the Brighter Future for Fairchild meeting at the FFD Building on Thursday, March 1<sup>st</sup> at 7:00 P.M. Chairman Meyer and Supervisor Anderson plan on attending. The meeting is open to all. (4) The county has U.S. Silica reactivating their county permitting.


The Audit was conducted by the TOF board.
