1. Call to Order

3. Land Stewardship 2150 document maps and figures

The Land Stewardship 2150 document maps and figures within the draft were reviewed. The maps with the corridors were not intended to be hard boundaries. These will be portrayed as conceptual boundaries. The intent of the maps is not to represent areas or blocks that need to be filled, but as areas which will help the concept of creating connecting corridors.

4. Land Acquisition Proposals for Consideration

It has been learned from several sources that one of the properties that has been in discussion has an accepted offer from a private party. The offer may have contingencies. Lewis questioned if the Land Stewardship Sub-Committee could be prepared for some type of offer if that accepted offer fell through for some reason. Stelljes stated because the Land Stewardship program relies upon other sources of funding such as grants, this would be difficult to put together. Stelljes and Koziel will contact the landowners directly to get details, which will help clarify the direction, if any, the sub-committee can take.

The sub-committee has done research on the Brown property, which has been referred to the Parks and Forest Committee. Dresel and Carlson will provide information to the Parks and Forest Committee to help them in their discussions.
