Adams	Pastures & feedlots are included but don't require a permit, they're subject to stds, same goes for waste utilization; Inc future amendment to stds as approved by LCC; ties in irrigation & waste leaving the property; inc 4 prohibitions; inc cropland & livestock perf. stds & inc c/s requirement	
Ashland	inc Ag perf stds & 4 prohibitions; inc an offer of c/s; issue a certificate of use; require permit for unconfined piles and manure aerial spray irrigation; future amendments to stds unless otherwise acted on by the LWCD;	
Barron	No earthen liners; future amendments to stds unless otherwise acted on by LCC	
Bayfield	Covers entire county; states all storage however in the definition it covers 30 days or more and/or has a capacity of 5,000 cuft or more; inc future amendments to stds; a permit, fee, and a NMP plan are not required for abandonment however the stds must be followed; there is no fee for the permits;	
Brown	inc unincorporated & incorporated areas that have delegated authority to the county; covers feedlots that exceed the prohibitions and receive an NOD & lots w/ 500 au or more & new feedlots w/ 40 au or more need a winter spreading permit for 12/1 thru 3/31; requires an unconfined manure stacking permit; landowners must plan and document availability of acceptable acres of cropland per au for future expansion using either PI or soil tet P in 590; NMP's due by June 1 each yr; inc 4 prohibitions, revised Oct. 2017	
Buffalo	stacked manure for more than 100 days requires permit; inc 4 prohibitions; LCC must approve future ammendment to stds; NMP by March 15 each year

Columbia	Covers all areas of county for feedlot runoff into ditches, animal waste impoundments and for feedlots, mismanaged pastures, unconfined stacks in WQMA's; direct runoff is subject to regulation; safety devices required; future amendments to stds unless otherwise acted on by LCC	

Crawford	No permit for less than 30 days and/or 7,000 cuft; current stds "and as may be amended from time to time"; NMP due May 1 yearly	
Dane	Entire county(uses 33.455); cert. of use for facilities beyond 20 yr lifespan and for those facilities that were not permitted; inc perf stds; future amendments to stds unless otherwise acted on by agency; no permit for less than 1,000 gal but must follow stds; inc a winter spreading permit

Door	inc perf stds; revised 9-27-18 to include silurian bedrock perf stds	
Douglas	have livestock lic ord; Lg scale CAFO ord & manure storage ord; no permit needed for less than 30 days and/or 5,000 cuft; future amendments to stds automatically included, covers entire county	
Dunn	unconfined manure piles are subject to regulation; stds at time of ordinance adoption, no permit fee

Trempealeau	inc 4 prohibitions & perf stds; "stacking in animal production area must be covered by plastic"; issue a cert of use; NMP due annually by April15, future amendments to stds unless otherwise acted on by LCC;

Wood	covers entire county; safety devices required; NMP filed annually by March 15; future amendments to stds unless otherwise acted on by the committee; "contaminated field runoff" shall be a violation; shall take water samples from wells as needed to verify there is not a significant discharge of process wastewater to groundwater or other waters of the state
