# FACT SHEET

#### **TO FILE NO. 18-19/080**

#### SUBJECT

Property purchase from Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WIDOT)

#### REQUEST

Purchase 42 acres from WIDOT for Three Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Three (\$385,363.00.00) for location of a future Highway Department facility

### **PURPOSE / JUSTIFICATION**

Eau Claire County has completed its site selection study and has identified this property to be the best value and location for possible future highway facility construction. The facility study that was completed and approved by the county board identified that an increase in acreage is needed for the operational needs of the Highway Department.

The Department of Transportation has completed a phase 1 environmental study on the property as well as a Phase 2 Environmental Sampling Investigation. The results of these studies show that DOT caused the contamination discovered on the property to date. By acquiring the property at least partially for blight elimination under Wis. Sat. §292.11(9)(e)1m. Eau Claire County will receive a local governmental liability exemption for the investigation and cleanup of contaminated property and solid waste management.

Fiscal Impact: \$385,363.00 from 2018 Highway Capital Funds
