Call of the Roll

<u>Public Input</u> - Per Committee operating procedures, a period of public input was held. No one was present at the meeting for public input.

<u>Approval of February 19, 2019 meeting minutes</u> – Motion made by Richard Eaton to approve the February 19, 2019 meeting minutes. Second by Ryan Dahlgren. The motion carried and the minutes were approved.

Report on Committee Progress

- -<u>Last Court Hearing & Report</u>: Richard Eaton attended the court hearing on February 21, 2019. At the hearing, he requested an extension of 180 days as we will not be able to find placement by April 6 deadline. This request was denied by Judge Harless. Another court hearing was scheduled for April 1, 2019, which Richard will attend and make another request for extension.
- -<u>Discussion about a house</u> currently used by another resident and potential for adding current client to this residency. Michael addressed concerns for code violations related to the laundry facilities at the residence. The room does not meet the 980 law and if presented by client's attorney as a consideration, the State will deny supporting this location. Concerns expressed too about the current resident and pending client have a history of not getting along at Sand Ridge facility. Placing pending client at this residence would have a negative impact on the success of the current resident. Richard will be having a follow up conversation with pending client's Attorney Peterson and stating all of the above concerns expressed by the State.
- -<u>DHS progress on new location</u> Nancy Huberty has been reaching out to Adult Family Home providers (REM, Lutheran Social Services, Aurora, Brotoloc) She also daily checks Craig's List and Zillow without good results.
- -Diane and Rod have met with County Administrator Kathryn Schauf to apprise her of the situation and potential budget impact on DHS including a conversation about county land for purchase. If county land option moves forward, we would not be able to put up a functional mobile home by the April 6 deadline.

Action Items:

- Richard will attend next hearing on April 1 to request extension; research room size standards; follow up with Planning & Development on the availability of county land
- -Nancy will continue to work with vendor and relators; AFH avenues also pursued
