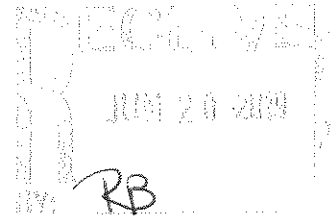

SECTION 1- TITLE AND PURPOSE

The title of this ordinance is the Town of Clear Creek ATV UTV Routes Ordinance. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish all-terrain vehicle routes in the town and to regulate the operation of all-terrain vehicles in the town per WI Statute 23.33

SECTION 2- AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Clear Creek, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin, adopts this Ordinance by authority of WI Statute 23.33

SECTION 3- OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES

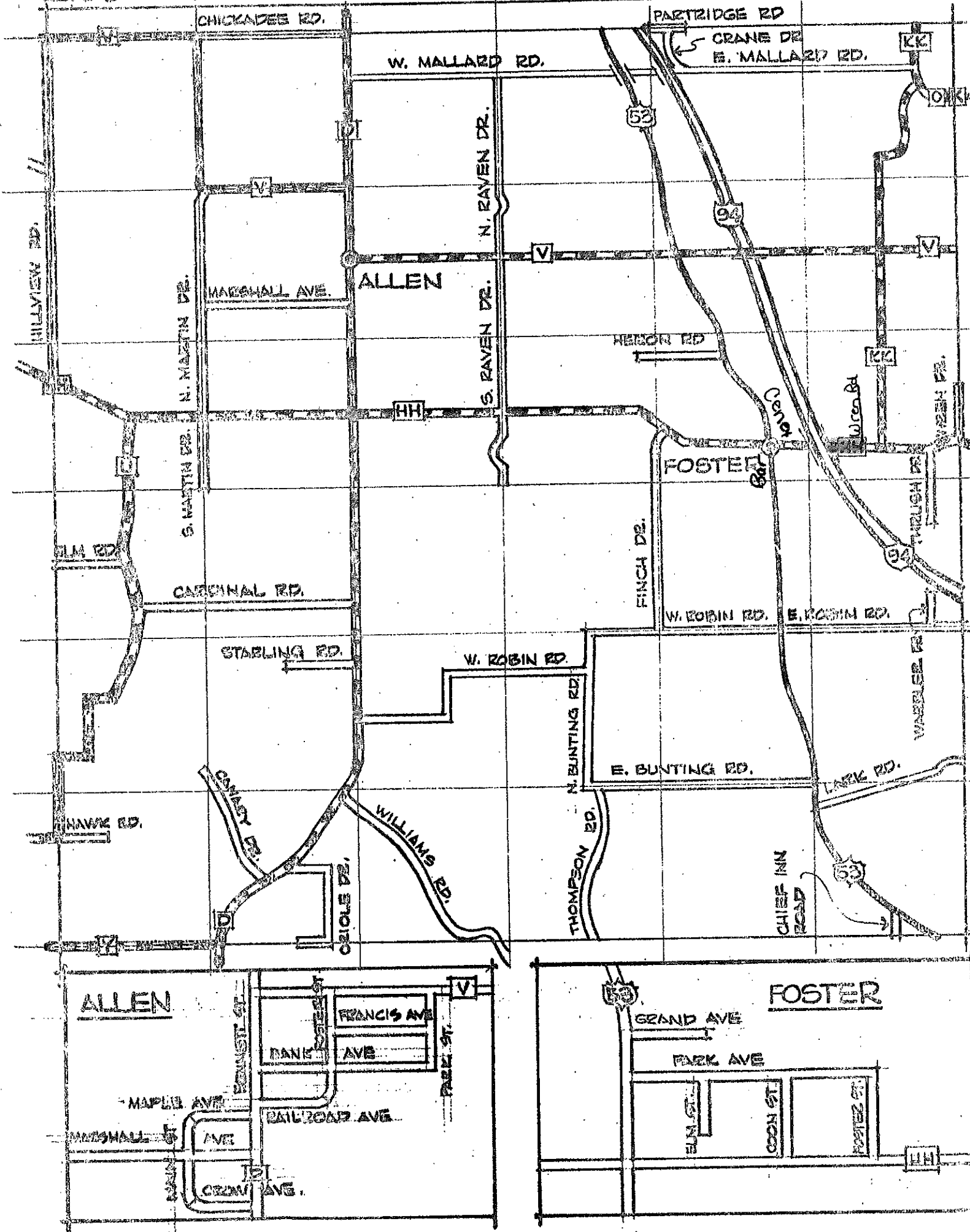
Pursuant to s23.33(4)(d4), Wis Stats, except as otherwise provided in s.23.33 (4) Wis. Stats, no person may operate an all-terrain vehicle on the roadway of any highway in the town except on roadways that are designated as all-terrain vehicle routes by this ordinance. Operation of all-terrain vehicles on a roadway in the town that is an all-terrain vehicle route is authorized only for the extreme right side of the roadway except that left turns may be made from any part of the roadway that is safe given the prevailing conditions. All-terrain vehicles must be operated on the paved portion of the roadway and not on the gravel shoulder.

SECTION 4- CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES

Pursuant to s.23.33 (8)(d), Wis Stats, the following restrictions are placed on the use of the town all-terrain vehicle routes designated in this ordinance:

- A. Routes shall be marked with uniform all-terrain vehicle route signs in accordance with s.NR64.12 (7), Wisconsin Administrative Code. No person may do any of the following in regard to signs marking town all-terrain vehicle routes.
 1. Intentionally remove, damage, deface, move, or obstruct any uniform all-terrain vehicle route or trail sign or standard or intentionally interfere with the effective operation of an uniform all-terrain vehicle trail sign or standards if the sign or standard is legally place by the state, any municipality or any authorized individual.
 2. Possess any uniform all-terrain vehicle route or trail sign or standard of the types established by the department for the warning, instruction or information of the public, unless he or she obtained the uniform all-terrain vehicle route or trail sign or standard in a lawful manner. Possession of a uniform all-terrain vehicle route or trail sign or standard creates a reasonable presumption of illegal possession.
- B. Operation shall be subject to all provisions of s23.33, Wis Stats, which is adopted as a part of this ordinance by reference, pursuant to s23.33 (11), Wis. Stats.
- C. A copy of this ordinance shall be sent by the town clerk to the Eau Claire County Sheriff Department.
- D. In addition to the provisions of s23.33 Wis. Stats, the following restrictions are in place for operators on the town all-terrain vehicle routes designated by this ordinance.
 1. All ATV/UTV operators shall observe a speed limit of not more than 35 MPH or the posted roadway speed limit, whichever is lower.
 2. All ATV/UTV operators shall ride single file.

Road Issues:

Jon Johnson, Eau Claire County Highway Dept., discussed the bridge on Bunting Rd. He said that the bridge rates 35 out of 100. The best option would be to apply for cost share program that the state pays 80%, the county 10%, and the township 10%. The earliest it could be replaced is in 2023 and would cost \$375,000 to \$400,000. Jon will be our sponsor and begin the process.

Application needs to be filed in October with an answer coming around February. Lotty made a motion that Jon Johnson begins the process with a second by Kyle Dimmitt.

Only one road bid for Mallard. Kyle Dimmitt made a motion to accept Monarch Paving's bid of \$3 . Second by Lotty Macik.

Cheryl Corbin was wondering about ATV signage from Wren Rd. to NB on ramp at I94. Carmen will fill our route form and take to the county for approval.

New Business:

Barrey and Grant Austin requested approval on a zoning change on 11.75 from AP to A2. The acreage will be split into two parcels. Motion to approve rezoning was made by Kyle Dimmitt with a second by Steven Carlson.
