



TO FILE NO. 19-20/062

As part of the approval of the 2019 Eau Claire County Budget, the County Board of Supervisors approved borrowing of \$9,795,809 in general obligation debt to pay for capital projects and highway improvements.

The attached resolution authorizes the sale of not to exceed \$10 million in General Obligation Promissory Notes, allocated as follows:

\$4,605,000	Highway Construction and Improvements
\$5,190,000	Other Capital Projects
\$250,000	Issuance Related Costs

Finally, I estimate that based on applying expected interest rates this issuance will add approximately \$1.3 million in additional debt service payments for each of the years 2020-2024, and approximately \$.8 million in additional debt service payments for each of the years 2025-2029. These amounts are based on five and ten year maturities associated with the useful life of the projects listed above.

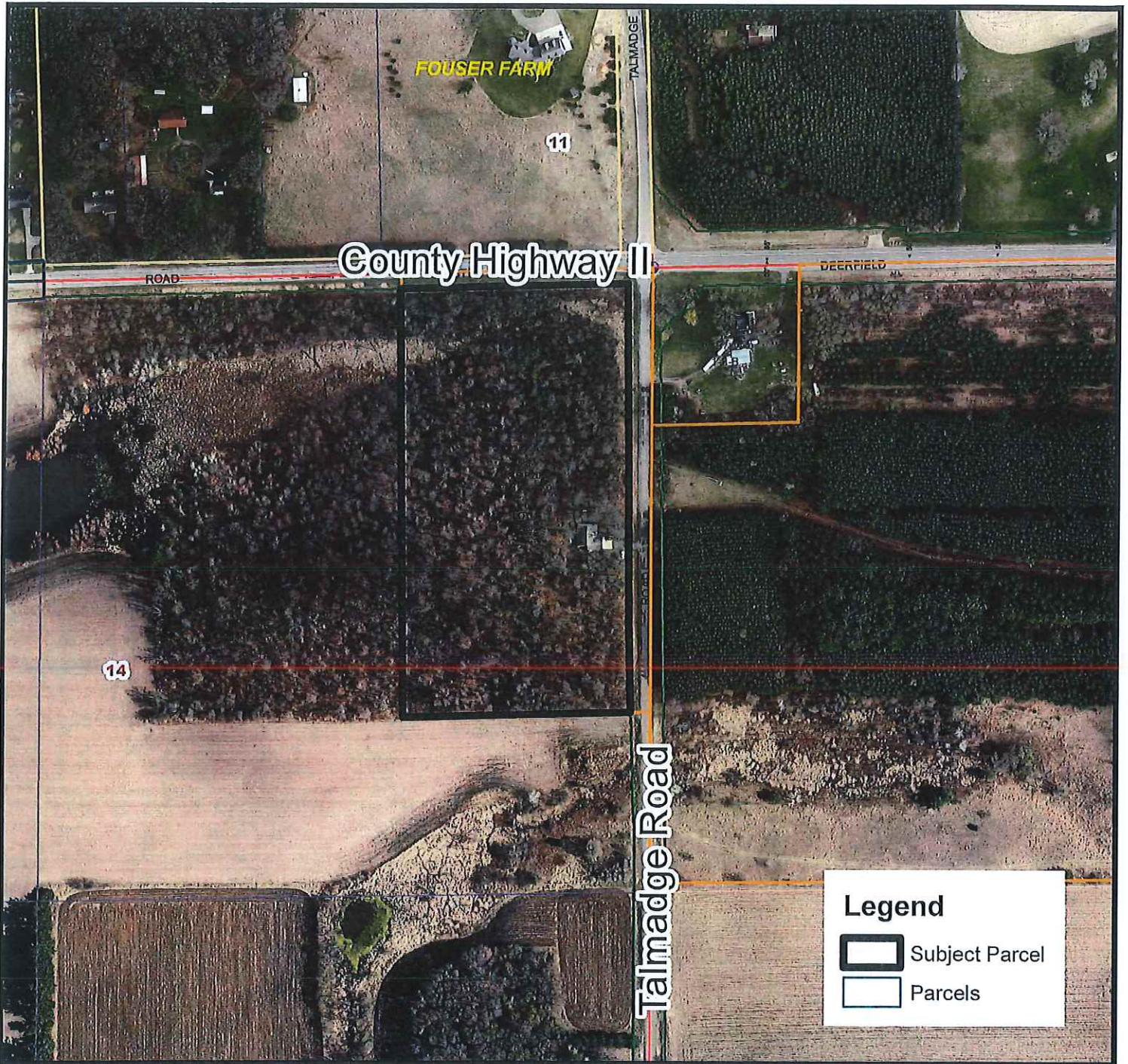

GARTMANN REZONE AERIAL MAP

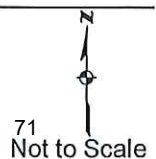

4 BILL 1522/P1 THAT SEEKS TO RESTORE VOTING RIGHTS TO PEOPLE ON
5 PROBATION AND PAROLE AND DECREASE FELONY DISENFRANCHISEMENT IN
6 THE STATE OF WISCONSIN
7

8 WHEREAS, felony disenfranchisement is defined as the loss of a person's voting rights
9 due to a felony conviction; and
10

11 WHEREAS, in the state of Wisconsin a person is not eligible to vote if they have been
12 convicted of a felony and currently serving any portion of their sentence including extended
13 supervision, probation and or parole; and
14

15 WHEREAS, rates of disenfranchisement vary drastically by state due to broad variations
16 in voting prohibitions; and
17

18 WHEREAS, as reported by The Sentencing Project, 30 states deny voting rights to felony
19 probationers, 34 states disenfranchise parolees, and 12 states deny voting rights to some or all
20 individuals who have successfully fulfilled their prison, parole or probation sentence; and
21

22 WHEREAS, Maine and Vermont are the only two states that do not disenfranchise
23 felons; and
24

25 WHEREAS, as of December 2016, the Bureau of Justice Statistics reported there were an
26 estimated 4.5 million adults in the U.S. under community supervision, probation or parole and,
27 of that amount, 64,900 were residents of the state of Wisconsin; and
28

29 WHEREAS, the Ex-Incarcerated People Organizing (EXPO) group reports in 2016 that
30 the average length of stay for parole in Wisconsin was estimated to be 38 months or a little over
31 three years, that makes Wisconsin third nationally for probation and parole sentences as reported
32 by the EXPO group; and
33

34 WHEREAS, the EXPO group further reports that the average duration for parole across
35 all states is estimated to be 22 months; and

36 WHEREAS, a report by the Advancement Project titled *Democracy Disappeared How*
37 *Florida Silences the Black Vote through Felony Disenfranchisement* published October 2018,
38 suggests that the consequences of felony disenfranchisement disproportionately impact poor
39 communities and communities of color, which are likely to have high concentrations of returning
40 citizens who are disenfranchised; and
41

42 WHEREAS, the report further indicates that losing the right to vote is linked to socio-
43 economic conditions; felony disenfranchisement converges with low income, poverty, limited
44 education and employment opportunities to disempower entire communities; and
45

1 WHEREAS, the inability for disenfranchised people convicted of a felony to participate
2 in the political process limits their power to overcome inequality and systemic injustice and
3 isolates them from society; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the Advancement Project reports that when large number citizens are not
6 allowed to vote, entire constituencies may go unrepresented in the democratic institutions that
7 govern them; and
8

9 WHEREAS, under Wisconsin Legislative Reference Bureau (LRB) draft legislation
10 1522/P1 a person would lose his or her right to vote based on a disqualifying offense only while
11 he or she is incarcerated for that offense and a person that is released to extended supervision or
12 parole may resume voting; and
13

14 WHEREAS, additionally, LRB 1522/P1 would allow a person convicted of a
15 disqualifying offense and on probation retain his or her right to vote unless he or she is confined
16 as a condition of probation; and
17

18 WHEREAS, EXPO, Wisconsin Affiliate of the Gamaliel Foundation (WISDOM), the
19 American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), Project Return, Wisconsin Voices, League of Women
20 Voters and Just Leadership USA plans to launch the “Unlock the Vote” Campaign seeking to
21 reengage 64,900 disenfranchised voters; and
22

23 WHEREAS, felony disenfranchisement is major social issue across the United States the
24 adversely affects more than 4 million people, including 64,900 people in the state of Wisconsin,
25 as it is a constitutional right that every citizen should be allowed the right to vote; now, therefore,

26 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Eau Claire County Board of
27 Supervisors supports Wisconsin Legislative Reference Bureau (LRB) draft legislation 1522/P1
28 that seeks to restore voting rights to disenfranchised felons and efforts to reduce felony
29 disenfranchisement and reform practices that disproportionately impacts communities of color in
30 Wisconsin and the United States; and


