The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chair Donald Mowry.

A motion was made by Mark Zuber and seconded by Tim Laubach to move into close session pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 19.85 (1)(e) for the purpose of discussing and sharing proprietary information from an outside agency in regard to research and potential revenue of that agency.

A motion was made by Mark Zuber and seconded by Lynn Thompson to move into open session at the conclusion of the closed session. All were in favor.

Sarah Lipke and Kevin Groskreutz left the meeting at 4:46 p.m.

Information was given by Dave Hayden in regard to the PSC grant and current expansion of wireless broadband in the eastern portion of Eau Claire County. Each tower has the potential to reach a 4 ½ mile radius.

The committee reviewed the PSC grant that is due December 19, 2019. The following points were highlighted:

- The grant is \$24 million
- Classes will be set up to assist agencies with the application process
- It would be beneficial to have a partnership/matching funds
- Potentially partner with CVTC
- Potentially only focus on Brunswick and Drammen

A special meeting will be held on October 3rd at 4:00 p.m. The item of discussion will be priorities of the grant. Mark Zuber will be meeting with 24/7 and will report back to the committee

A motion was made by Mark Zuber to adjourn the meeting at 5:44 p.m.
