DECLARATION OF THE EXISTENCE OF A COUNTY EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Eau Claire County Code Chapter 2.36 and Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 323 grants authority to Chairperson of the Eau Claire County Board Supervisors, upon the recommendation of the Emergency Management Coordinator to declare the existence of an emergency within the County; and,

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the United States Department of Health and Human Services declared a Public Health Emergency, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a pandemic, and on March 12, 2020 the Governor of the State of Wisconsin declared a Health Emergency in the State; and,

WHEREAS, Eau Claire County has been working to protect the health and well-being of its residents from the spread of COVID-19, and to prepare for the impacts the disease is likely to have on the County; and

WHEREAS, the Eau Claire County Board has determined that it is necessary to make all possible resources and means available to the County in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents from the threat posed by the continued spread of COVID-19; and,

NOW THERFORE IT IS HEREBY DECLARED, Pursuant to Eau Claire County Code Chapter 2.36 and Wisconsin Statutes Sections 323.11 and 323.14(4), as Chairperson of the Eau Claire County Board of Supervisors I do hereby declare that a public health emergency exists in Eau Claire County, and do hereby authorize the exercise of emergency powers as permitted under state statutes and the county code and consistent with the Eau Claire County emergency management plan based on the need to plan for and respond to the potential of an imminent crisis; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this declaration shall be in effect until such time as a quorum of the Eau Claire County Board of Supervisors can convene and ratify this declaration of emergency.

RE: DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

This resolution is being brought to the board for ratification of the chair's declaration of emergency, on an emergency basis.

The Governor has issued orders with regards to potential gatherings, limiting those gatherings to 50 or less. The Center for Disease Control has issued guidelines for gatherings of less than 50.

Among other things this resolution would authorize the Chair to authorize remote attendance at committee and board meetings, as long as they continue to provide reasonable access to the public in compliance with the law. The declaration also allows the County to alter purchasing rules related to the emergency in order to purchase those items necessary for emergency response and preparedness.

Eau Claire County is taking this action in preparation for the imminent crisis related to the Covid-19 virus. It puts necessary resources in place and allows the county to adjust functions of government and rules of how meetings are conducted to allow for the safety of the public, board members and staff.

RATIFYING THE DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS

WHEREAS, in December 2019, a novel strain of coronavirus known as COVID-19 was detected, and COVID-19 has continued to spread throughout the world, including to the United States and the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the federal government, state governments, and local governments are working together to contain the further spread of the disease and treat existing cases; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the United States Department of Health and Human Services declared a Public Health Emergency, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a pandemic, and on March 12, 2020 the Governor of the State of Wisconsin declared a Health Emergency in the State; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020 Eau Claire County Board Chair, Nick Smiar declared a state of emergency for Eau Claire County with regards to the need to plan for and respond to the potential of an imminent health crisis related to Covid-19 virus, and;

WHEREAS, Eau Claire County has been working to protect the health and well-being of its residents from the spread of COVID-19, and to prepare for the impacts the disease is likely to have on the County; and

WHEREAS, the Eau Claire County Board has determined that it is necessary to make all possible resources and means available to the County in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents from the threat posed by the continued spread of COVID-19.

WHEREAS, under Wisconsin Statute §252.03, the Eau Claire City-County Health Department is the lead agency for controlling and responding to communicable disease threats and has opened Incident Command to plan for and respond to meet the needs of our residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 323.11, and Chapter 2.36 of the Eau Claire County Code of General Ordinances, the Eau Claire County Board ratifies the declaration of emergency issued by Nick Smiar, County Board Chairman that finds and declares that a state of emergency exists within the County by reason of an imminent threat of disaster impairing medical care, health, and other critical systems of the County due to the spread of COVID-19; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the period of emergency prescribed by this Resolution, the Board may order, by ordinance or resolution, whatever is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, protection, and welfare of persons and property within the County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Board Chairman, Nick Smiar and County Administrator Kathryn Schauf are hereby authorized and directed by the Eau Claire County Board to coordinate and administer the County's emergency management response and to carry out the orders of the Board related thereto; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Head of Emergency Management of the County51is authorized and directed to carry out his duties under the County's Emergency Management Plan

under the supervision and direction of the County Administrator and perform such other duties as may be directed by further resolution of the Board; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the period of emergency the County Board Chair will have the power to cancel meetings if needed and to determine the availability of and to authorize County Board Supervisors to attend meetings of the Board remotely in a manner that is consistent with applicable laws and that are reasonably accessible to members of the public: and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, based upon the information available to the Board and the ongoing threat posed by the spread of COVID-19, the period of emergency shall continue for sixty (60) days from the effective date of this Resolution unless sooner terminated or extended by further resolution of the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all actions heretofore taken by the Board and other appropriate public officers and agents of the County with respect to the matters contemplated under this Resolution are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.
