Moritz called the meeting to order at 5 p.m. and confirmed public posting of the meeting.

The committee reviewed the minutes from the March 2, 2020 meeting. Lavelle moved to approve the minutes as presented. It passed unanimously.

No members of the public were present.

Laura Hurd was present to discuss the Boy Scout proposal to update the portable toilets at Pinter Pines.

Jay and Laura Plummer presented the results of the 2020 Powder Keg event at Lowes Creek in February. All surrounding local news groups were in attendance, and the event had many sponsors. Lowes Creek will be the location of the 2021 Nationals. Details of the 2020 Firecracker were presented. CORBA is in need of a temporary storage shed on the grounds. They will bring a proposal to the next meeting to present to the committee.

Schraufnagel commented that she would like to proceed with the buckthorn project in the near future, which would entail a group of volunteers going into Lowes Creek to pull baby buckthorn.

The Eau Claire County Fair Committee was present to discuss the 2020 fair contract rates. Gibson motioned to allow the fair to operate at the same fair rates as the previous year for a one year lease. In exchange for the discounted rates, the Fair Committee will participate in event set up and the post event clean up. The motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

Short term and long term options were discussed for the Highway D Bridge canoe landing. No action was taken at this time.

Director Pedersen gave an update on the 15 year plan. There will be an Advisory Board meeting April 6 for further input on the plan and discussion of ideas. June 9, 2020 is a possible date to schedule a public forum in Eau Claire to discuss the plan.

Due to the COVID-19 public health emergency, the committee discussed refunds for Eau Claire County facility/park reservations. Schraufnagel made a motion to allow for all Eau Claire County facility reservations and camping fees be refunded fully upon request of cancellation during the National Emergency. The motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

The next meeting date was set for April 13th at 5:00 PM at the Ag Center.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:19 p.m.
