1) Call to Order

Chair Leary called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m. A quorum was present.

2) Confirmation of Compliance with Open Meetings Law

Leary confirmed compliance with the open meetings law.

3) Public Comment Period

Dane Zook introduced himself. He has recently been active with the Eau Claire River Watershed Coalition and is heading up the Fall Creek inland lake district. Everyone welcomed Dane.

4) Approve Minutes of January 27, 2020 meeting

ACTION: Motion by Gibson/Adams to approve minutes as presented. Motion carried, 6-0-0.

5) Review Vouchers and Ledger Update

The January expenditures and revenues were reviewed.

6) Land Conservation Commission Citizen Members

Citizen members Adams' and Strauch's terms continue until April. They have been mailed renewal information from the County Administrators office. Solie's membership is determined by Farm Service Agency as outlined in state statute.

7) Water Quality Task Force/ Recent Legislation

Leonard led a discussion on the recent legislation package as a result of the Water Quality Task Force. Members directed Leonard to review with Wisconsin Land+Water which pieces of legislation will need the most support.

8) Cover Crops & Healthy Soils workshop update

Staff provided an update on the recent workshop. Nearly 50 people attended the Augusta workshop hosted by Eau Claire County, and approximately 40 attended the Thorp workshop hosted by Clark County. Adams attended the Augusta workshop and was impressed.

9) Manure storage, manure transfer systems, and barn gutters

Leonard provided a review; no significant updates to the issue.

10) Area meeting and Poster & Speaking Contest

Adams and staff provided an update.

11) Committee, Staff and Agency Updates

Brief updates were provided as follows.

- b) **Targeted Runoff Management (TRM) program:** Nothing further was reported.

- h) **UW-Extension:** It was noted that the Fair will occur one week after Farm Technology Days.

Manure Storage/barn gutters will be on the next meeting agenda.



RESOLUTION

Authorizing the Eau Claire County Land Conservation Commission (LCC) Chair, or LCC Vice-Chair, with the Land Conservation Division (LCD) Manager to act on behalf of LCC to approve Cost-Share applications for the installation of Best Management Practices.

WHEREAS, Eau Claire County LCC has adopted Soil and Water Conservation Requirements and Agricultural Performance Standards for the protection and improvement of the soil and water resources of Eau Claire County; and

WHEREAS, installation of Conservation Best Management Practices (BMPs) often utilize federal, state, and county funds available through cost-share programs which require approval of the Eau Claire LCC; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Eau Claire County LCC authorizes the LCC Chair or LCC Vice-chair, in addition to the Land Conservation Manager, to act on behalf of the Eau Claire County LCC to:

- Approve and enter into cost-share agreements, including those which may contain economic hardship provisions, utilizing federal, state, or county funds within the cost-share program guidelines and granting authority;
- Approve and enter into cost-share agreement amendments which require LCC approval;
- Authorize cost-share payment to landowner/operator after payment is requested, evidence of contractor payment by landowner/operator has been received, and grantee has verified proper BMP installation;
- Sign and submit reimbursement claims along with necessary supporting documentation;
- Take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete the approved project.

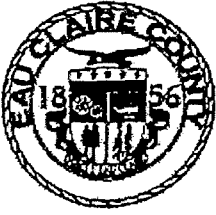
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Land Conservation Manager will report all actions taken under this authorization to the LCC at their next meeting, and

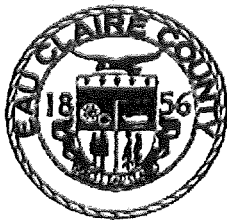

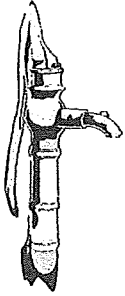

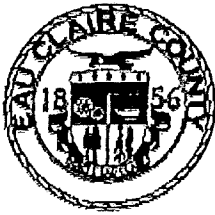
