Update July 1, 2020

The Eau Claire County Taskforce has been working on a plan to resume in-person appearances including jury trials. Once their recommendation is complete, it will be forwarded for approval to the Chief Judge for the 10th Judicial District, Maureen Boyle, prior to implementation.

Commercial Docket

Beginning July 1, 2020 the 10th Judicial District, which includes Eau Claire County, will begin accepting commercial docket filings. The case will stay in the proper county in which you file and the Judge will be randomly assigned. The commercial docket court Judges for the 10th District are Judge Nordstrand, Judge Schumacher, and Judge Waterman. Individuals who were issued an OWI 1st citation, or those with a return date after having had a pre-trial conference with the prosecuting agency, can appear by Zoom for their court date starting on July 14, 2020.
