Completion Rates of CTC Bond Conditions

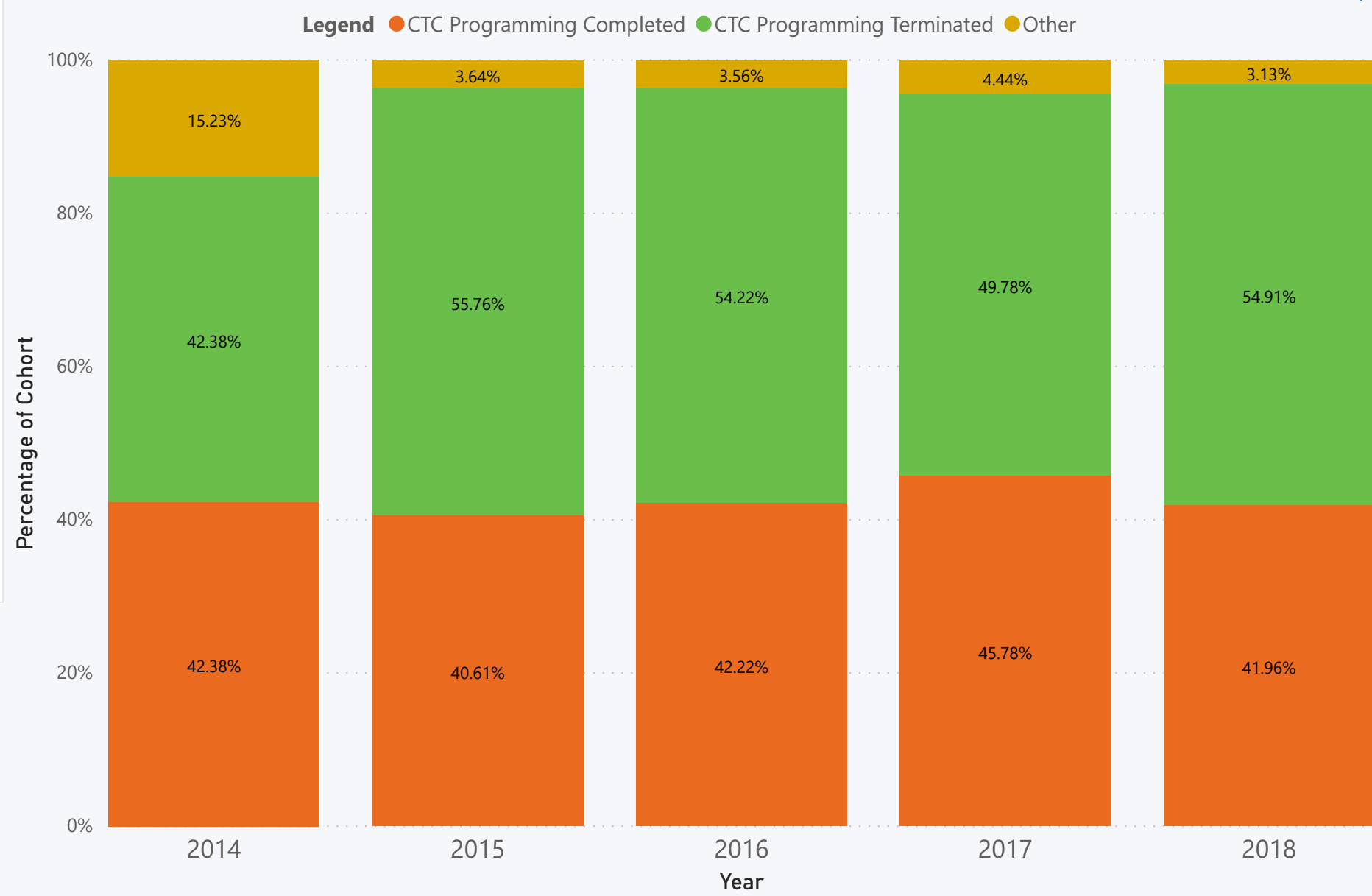
Individuals that live in Eau Claire County are at times assigned Community Transition Center (CTC) programming as part of their bond conditions. This slide looks at the completion and termination rates of CTC programming when assigned as a bond condition.

If an individual maintains the requirements of the CTC protocol until their case is disposed or the CTC condition is removed from their bond, they are deemed to have **"completed CTC."**

For the most part **terminations** result from numerous violations of the requirements placed on the individual by CTC. Final termination is determined by CTC case managers and is based on a set of criteria that was formulated by a collaboration of the courts, DA's office, and public defenders.

The **other** category contains special and unique circumstances that keep individuals from finishing CTC programming. At this time, those situations are evaluated separately.

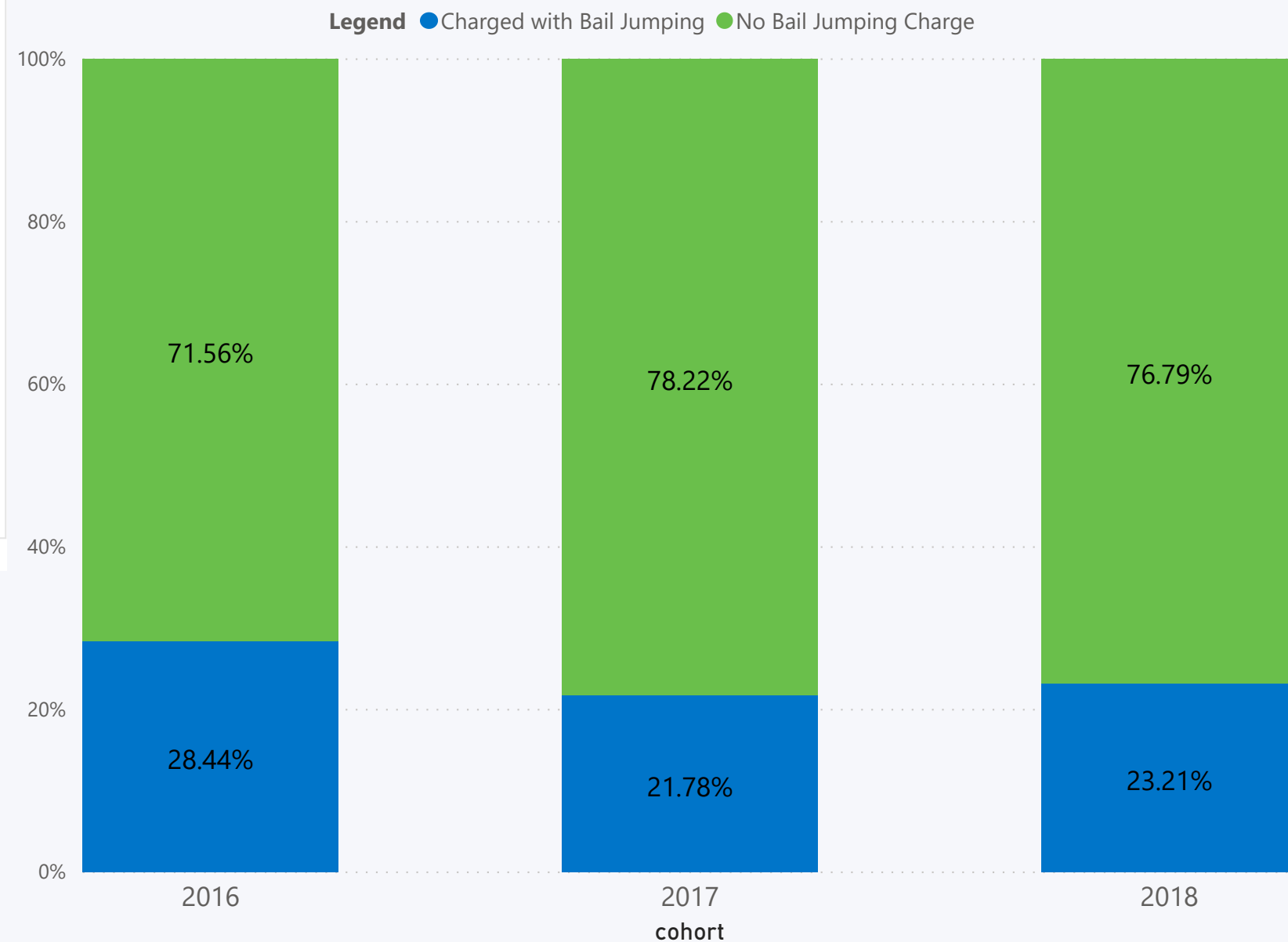
CTC Bond Referrals that Resulted in Bail Jumping.

In addition to termination from CTC programming, the DA's office may choose to pursue bail jumping charges as the result of CTC programming violations.

This slide looks at the percentage of CTC bond clients that received a bail jumping charge. When comparing this slide to the previous slide, you can see that not all of the individuals that were terminated from CTC programming received a bail jumping charge.

This data has only been tracked since 2016. In addition, the data for this slide only includes individuals enrolled in CTC through the end of 2018 as not all 2019 participants had finished their programming at the time of this analysis.

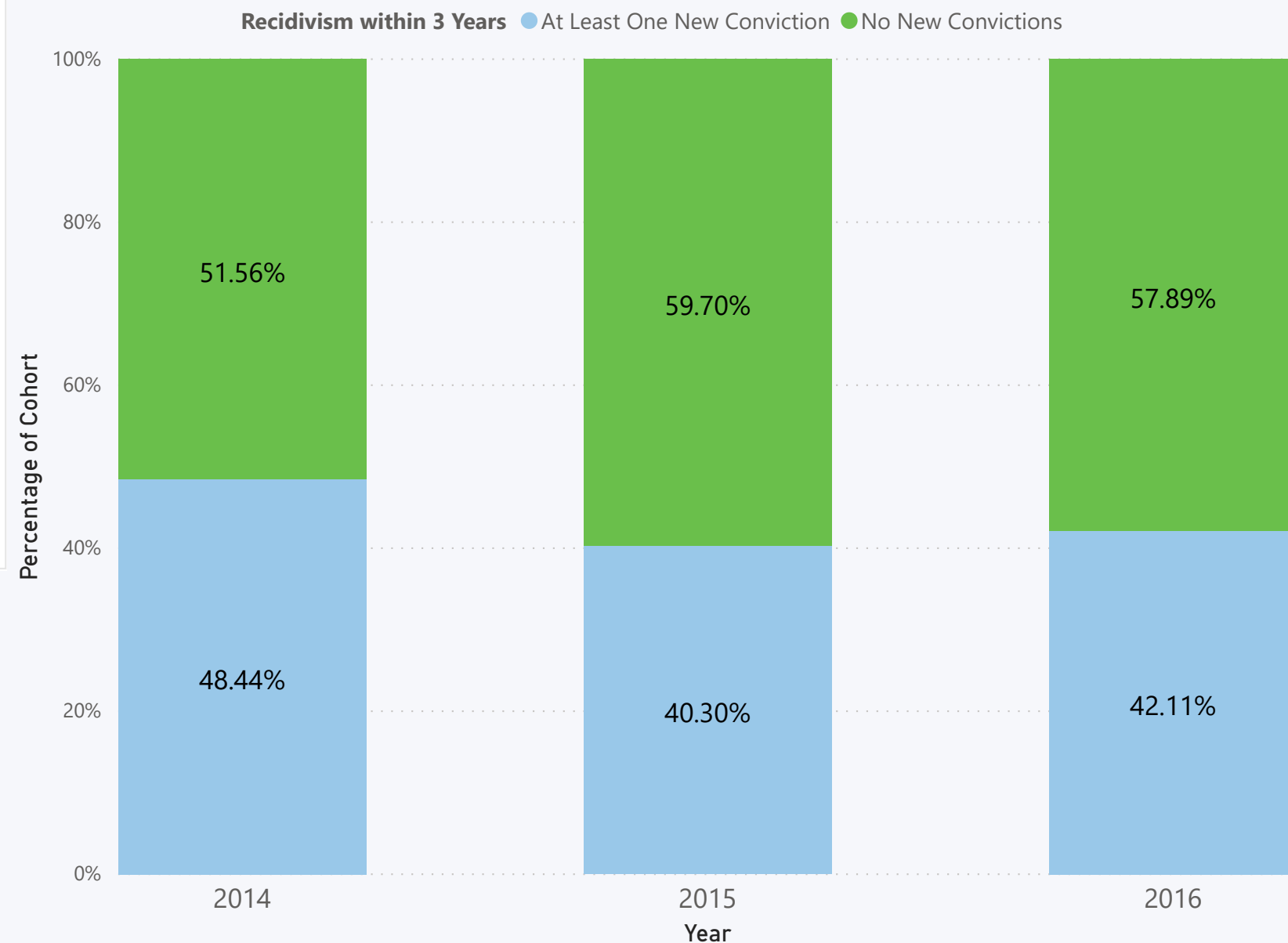


Bond Referrals that Completed CTC: 3 Year Recidivism Rates -- New Criminal Convictions (Felony/Misdemeanor)

This slide only looks at the group of individuals who "completed CTC" as defined on the first slide.

Recidivism in the chart to the right is measured from the end-date of an individual's CTC programming. In addition, bail-jumping only convictions were not included when calculating recidivism to allow for a better comparison between the groups.

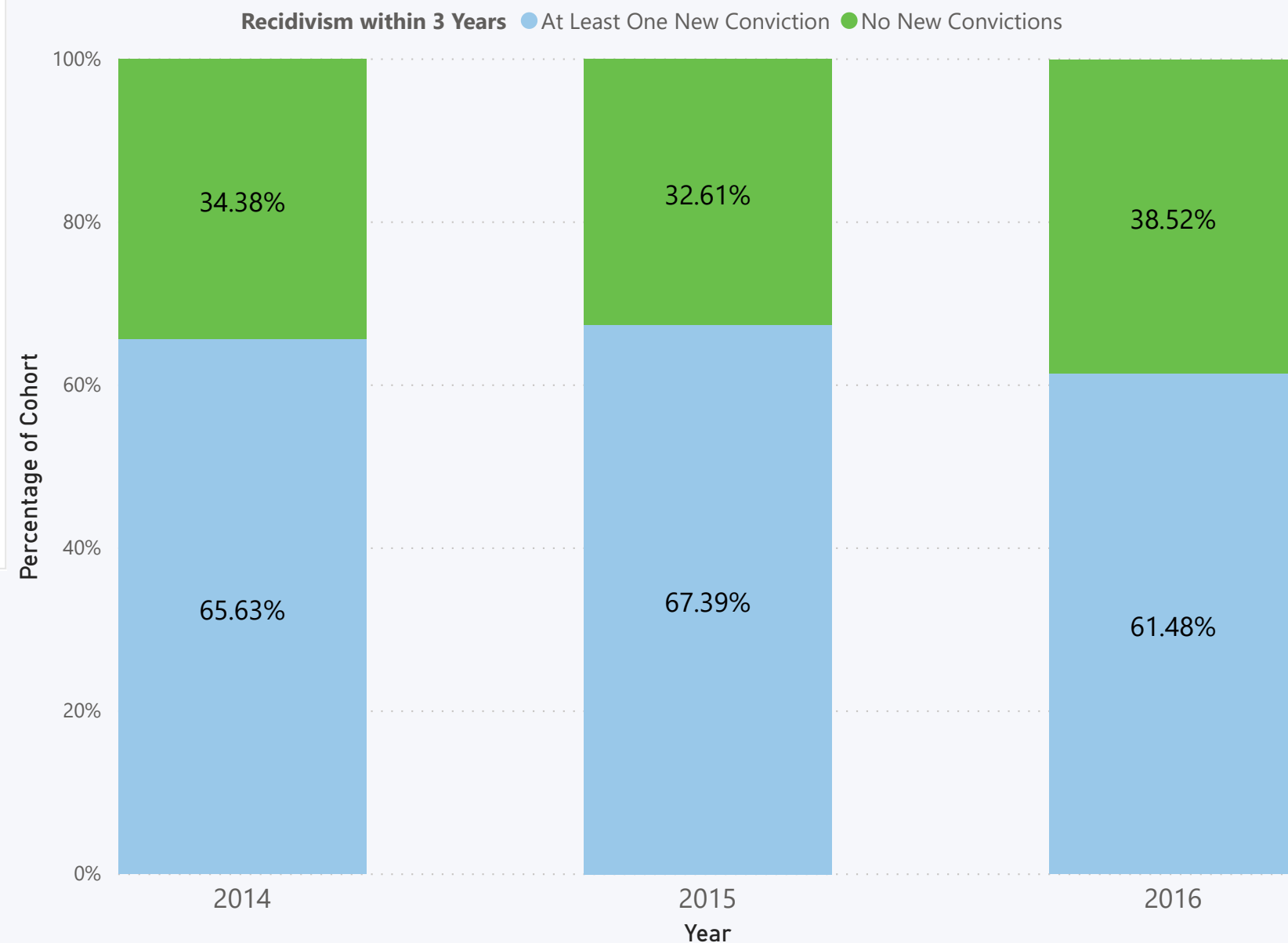


CTC Bond Referrals that were **Terminated**: 3 Year Recidivism Rates -- New Criminal Convictions (Felony/Misdemeanor)
