1. Call to order and confirmation of meeting notice

Chairperson Mowry call to order the meeting at 4:05 p.m. and he confirmed that the meeting was properly noticed.

4. Review/Approval of Committee Minutes from October 22, 2020 - Discussion/Action

The committee reviewed the meeting minutes of October 22nd. Luke Hanson motioned to approve the minutes as presented. Scott Hoffman seconded the motion; motion carried on a voice vote with all in favor of the motion.

5. Letters of Support for the Drammen and Brunswick PSC Application - Discussion

Don Mowry and Rod Eslinger presented the letter of support for these projects.

6. Digital Literacy Proposal - Information/Discussion

Don Mowry presented the UW-EC digital literacy proposal with the committee and answered questions. This will serve a need in our community and ties into the grant applications.

7. Lake Eau Claire – Astera PSC Application – Discussion

Dave Hayden and Rod Eslinger gave the background of the project. Mr. Hayden indicated that he had communicated with the Astera team. The committee directed staff to draft a letter of support on their behalf. Sara Lipke suggested that the Broadband committee support all broadband expansion projects as it extends broadband service in Eau Claire County and it aligns with the committee's goals. Lynn Thompson motioned to direct staff to prepare a letter of support for the Lake Eau Claire/Astera project, Luke Hanson, seconded the motion: motion was carried on a voice vote with all in favor of the motion.

8. SpaceX Starlink Project - Discussion/Action

Dave Hayden and Tom Lange presented on the SpaceX Starlink proposal in Eau Claire County. Dave shared a service map with the committee that showed the area to be covered in rural Augusta. He noted the service costs and indicated that the County would secure the Angela account status. There is a \$25,000 grant available from the WEDC that would cover the costs of the equipment and the remaining fees would be passed along to the subscribers. The pilot project would be limited to 50 users. The anticipated monthly fee is \$99.

Mark Zuber motioned that the committee support the SpaceX Starlink Pilot Project provided the County approves its role as an Angel Account Agency, Luke Hanson seconded the motion; motioned carried on a voice vote with all in favor of the motion.

9. Wisconsin State Telecommunication Association (WSTA) offer - Discussion/Action

Rod Eslinger indicated that the County accepted assistance from the Wisconsin State Telecommunication Association offer to partner with a representative to help further our broadband connections.
