COVID-19 and the Eau Claire County Circuit Courts Status Update

- The Temporary Order Suspending Jury Trials and In-Person Court Appearances in Eau Claire County is still in effect.
- Reminder that requests for in-person hearings must be made in writing to the Judge a minimum of 3 days prior to the hearing date. If your request is denied, the Court hearing will be held remotely by video or phone.
- Helpful information for all parties and counsel regarding remote appearances can be found on our homepage.
- REMINDER Criteria for use of the Zoom Room:
 - ONLY when defendants show up at the courthouse and <u>don't</u> have a phone (most likely during 11:00 Initial Appearances)
 - o Criminal Case Defendants Only at this time
 - o Only one person in the room at a time due to social distancing requirements
 - o Defendant should report to Clerk of Courts to request use of the room.
