COVID-19 and the Eau Claire County Circuit Courts Status Update

A Memo regarding In-person/Zoom Hearing Rules was sent out to criminal court practitioners and staff from Presiding Judge Schumacher on June 22, 2021. This outlines some bright line rules to be followed going forward.

We are currently able to utilize the jury rooms in Branch 2 and Branch 3, rather than the courtroom as the jury room. Trials held in the Branch 1 and Branch 4 courtrooms, will utilize the courtroom or the law library as the jury room.

Eviction Moratorium

Effective June 29, 2021 the CDC extended the <u>Order Regarding the Temporary Halt in Residential Evictions</u> through July 31, 2021. This is intended to be the final extension of the moratorium.

Appellate Court E-filing
