RE: Fact Sheet 21-22.028 Deleting Sections 4.09.040, 10.20.010A.3., and 10.20.015

This ordinance deletes section 4.09.040, 10.20.010 A.3., and 10.20.015 from the County Code.

These sections of the code were created in the 1980's. While it may have functioned as an impound lot in the 1980's the Altoona Highway facility has not been used to impound vehicles for many years and will be soon moving to its new location on U.S, Highway 53. Currently, vehicles that are ordered towed, are towed by private towing companies, who charge the owner of the vehicle directly for the cost of towing and storage. Owners who are present at the site of the accident or disabled vehicle, or who can be contacted by law enforcement, have the option to designating a preferred towing company, with exception for time and availability. If the owner does not designate a preferred towing company then the towing company is chosen by the Communications Center from a rotating list of companies. Statute and county code make the owner of the vehicle responsible for the cost of towing and storage. Private towing companies remove the cost of towing and storage from the county by charging the owner directly.

Chapter 4.09 of the code is the "County Accounts" chapter of the code. This chapter of the code designates and assigns an account number for the various financial accounts found within the county. Section 4.09.040 designates two highway department accounts for towing and impoundment purposes. Because vehicles are no longer towed/impounded at the highway facility these accounts are no longer needed. Section 10.20.010 A.3. references back to Section 4.09.040 and should be deleted. Section 10.20.015 references the "department yard" in Altoona as being the county vehicle pound.

An ordinance like this was considered in 2019. That ordinance was tabled because of concern about the cost of towing charges. A review of the system and towing procedures of the Sheriff and City of Eau Claire was conducted and it was determined that the current methods are consistent with the law and are appropriate.

## TO FILE NO. 21-22/030

This resolution amends the 2021 Eau Claire County budget by transferring \$12,000 of unspent Information Systems Capital Projects funds to provide funding for the water heater and floor replacement in the Cedar Lodge at Beaver Creek Reserve.

Earlier this summer, a hot water heater at Cedar Lodge malfunctioned and flooded the laminate flooring resulting in a total loss.

Amendment of the 2021 Budget requires a 2/3 vote of the county board and publication of a Class 1 notice by the county clerk.

Fiscal Impact: none; reallocation of unspent bond proceeds

Chair Pagonis called the Committee on Finance & Budget to order at 4:30 pm and confirmed compliance with open meetings law.

The committee clerk took roll call. Members of both committees present are indicated above.

No members of the public wished to speak.

Glenda Lyons presented the quarter 1 financial report for the Treasurer's office.

Sue McDonald presented the quarter 1 financial report for the County Clerk's office.

Norb Kirk presented the quarter 1 financial report for the Finance department.

Norb Kirk presented the quarter 1 Director's Report. The committee would like unemployment statistics reported under economic indicators. ECC's unemployment rate for April was 3.5% and there is a workforce shortage.

The committee reviewed the April Investment Report, the Sales Tax report, and Vehicle Registration Fee report. Interest rates are at .05% and it will be likely that interest revenue will be under budget by \$65,000. Glenda reported that the current cash balance is \$100 million. This includes the Highway borrowing, the annual capital borrowing, and the ARPA funds.

The committee reviewed the updated 2020 general fund estimate.

The committee reviewed proposed updates to the procurement card manual.

Kathryn Schauf gave an update on the American Rescue Plan Act funds. The county would like to create an ARPA task force which would develop a fair and equitable process for fund distribution through a third-party administrator and application process. The Committee on Administration would submit third party administrator recommendations to the county board for final approval.

Beaver Creek Reserve sustained damage to the floor in the Cedar Lodge from flooding from a water heater. The quote to replace the flooring is \$10,042. The insurance deductible is \$10,000. BCR does not have funds available to pay for the repair or deductible.

The committee discussed possible options for public input sessions in July, one in person and one via video. Supervisor Pagonis would like Barb Pritzl and Mary Pica-Anderson to present portions of their 2022 budget requests.
