# COVID-19 and the Eau Claire County Circuit Courts Status Update

Effective July 30, 2021, Eau Claire County now requires masks for entry into the building.

Beginning August 2, 2021, Criminal Intake will be in person by default. Check your notice of hearing for further direction. Requests for remote appearance, must be made in writing at least 5 business days prior to the hearing.

### **Eviction Moratorium**

The eviction moratorium ended on Saturday, July 31, 2021.

# **Second Floor Security Screening**

This summer has seen a huge increase in the number of individuals being screened onto the second floor. This is due in large part to the increase of inperson hearings and the resumption of jury trials. For example, January and February saw an average of 1,475 per month, June and July saw an average of 3,800 per month!
