DRAFT: MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING between Extension Eau Claire County and the Eau Claire County Fair Committee

Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding establishes the guidelines for collaboration between Extension Eau Claire County (referred to as Extension) and the Eau Claire County Fair Committee (referred to as Fair Committee). The purpose of this MOU is to define the roles, relationships, and obligations of the parties as it relates to the Eau Claire County Fair.

Introduction

Extension Eau Claire County is an education arm of Eau Claire County and is part of UW-Madison Division of Extension and the Land Grant University's Cooperative Extension System and the United States Department of Agriculture. The educators with Extension Eau Claire County cooperate with the Fair Committee to support the education associated with the Eau Claire County Fair.

The Fair Committee is a working committee comprised of citizen volunteers that provide hands-on assistance in producing a well-run, family-oriented and sustainable fair for all. As members of a county committee, volunteers must comply with all federal, state and county non-discrimination laws and policies. The Eau Claire County Fair is conducted on land owned by the county and marketed as the "Expo Center."

The 4-H Name and Emblem is a Federal trade mark and can be used only as authorized by land grant universities' Extension 4-H state offices and their local 4-H employee designees. Criminal misuse of the 4-H name and emblem is prohibited by 18 U.S.C. 707. The primary consideration for granting authorization to use the 4-H Name and Emblem is for the educational and character-building purposes of the 4-H program to serve the educational needs and interests of 4-H youth.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Joint responsibilities: Extension and the Fair Committee mutually agree to work together to:

- 1. Provide open communication and leadership to achieve the mission and goals of this partnership.
- 2. Each entity acknowledges that they are responsible for the reporting and filing associated with their organization.
- 3. Use the official and approved logo and identifying mark for each partner on all communications and promotional materials in equal size. See the 4-H Name and Emblem use guide here: 4-H Name and Emblem Wisconsin 4-H
- 4. Work collaboratively to update the Fair Book, annually.
- 5. Uphold the policies of the Eau Claire County Fair as outlined in the Eau Claire County Fair Premium Book and Wisconsin Administrative Code ATCP 160 County and District Fairs.

Extension agrees to:

- 1. Allow the Eau Claire County Fair to use the 4-H Name and Emblem in accordance with the federal law, regulations, and guidelines regarding use of the 4-H Name and Emblem. The emblem may be used for marketing, communication pieces including letters, postcards, etc.
- 2. Advise the Fair Committee on programming, Fair Book updates, and other topics as a non-voting member on the Fair Committee.
- 3. Provide educational programming in accordance with the "Roles and Responsibilities" document on Fairs at the EC County Fair.
- 4. Promote exhibition at the EC County Fair to youth enrolled in the 4-H program and families who participate in Extension programming.
- 5. Facilitate sign up of youth enrolled in Cloverbuds and Exploring for face-to-face judging.

Junior Fair Committee agrees to:

1. Provide structure, guidelines, and policies to run the Eau Claire County Fair in support of Positive Youth Development.

Meetings and Reporting

To accomplish these objectives, partners will meet/confer regularly for the purposes of program planning, monitoring, and evaluating outcomes.

Termination or Amendments

- 1. This agreement becomes effective upon the document being signed and filed with the relevant parties.
- The 4-H Educator and the Fair Committee Chair will meet to review this Memorandum of Understanding. This meeting shall occur between the end of the Fair and November 1.
- 3. This agreement shall be for a five (5) year period and will be renewed upon mutual agreement of the parties. The terms of the MOU may be amended during the five (5) year period upon mutual agreement of the parties as evidenced in writing.
- 4. Termination Clause: If either party wishes to withdraw from this agreement at any time outside of the five-year period, notification needs to be provided to the other party by November 1, with a final decision by November 30.
