## EAU CLAIRE COUNTY NONMETALLIC MINE PERMIT

Mathy Construction Co., 920  $10^{\rm th}$  Avenue, Onalaska, WI, 54650, has been granted a permit according to Chapter 18.90, General Code of Ordinances for Eau Claire County, to excavate from property located in the S1/2, SW1/4-SE1/4; the W1/2-NE1/4-SE1/4; the E1/2-NW1/4-SW1/4; the E1/2-SW1/4-SW1/4; and the E1/2-SW1/4, all located in Section 4, T26N-R10W, Town of Brunswick subject to all conditions of approval. Failure on your part to notify the Department of any objections within five (5) workdays of the receipt of this permit will constitute acceptance of this permit and all conditions and amendments to the application and plans.

This permit is issued on June 23, 2003. An annual fee is required before June 23, 2003 of each year this project remains active. Failure to pay the fee before the anniversary date will void this permit. This permit includes phases of development at 10 acres intervals. Mathy construction shall notify the Department 30 days in advance of starting a new phase.

You must notify the Eau Claire County Planning and Development Department, 721 Oxford Avenue, Eau Claire, WI 54703-5441, in writing at least thirty (30) workdays prior to final completion of project reclamation unless other arrangements have been approved.

You are responsible for obtaining any permit or approval required for your project under Wisconsin state statutes or administrative codes, local government ordinance(s), or federal regulations such as those of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers before starting your project. Failure to obtain those approvals will invalidate this permit

You must allow free and unlimited access to your project site at any time to any Department employee who is investigating the project's construction, operation or maintenance.

All individuals operating equipment at the project site must be made aware of the provisions contained in this permit.

This permit may be revoked if you do not conform with the conditions outlined herein. If you fail to comply with applicable laws or this permit, including failure to obtain approval to expand or deviate from the approved plans, this permit may be revoked and reclamation ordered.

The project must be limited to the horizontal dimensions and depth as indicated on the reclamation plan. No mining or stockpiling of material may occur outside the marked boundaries. Progressive and final reclamation must be carried out according to the approved plans and permit conditions. The marked boundaries shall be staked and shall not be modified without prior approval.

Reclaimed areas shall have slopes that do not exceed three (3) feet of horizontal to one (1) foot vertical incline or as depicted in the reclamation plan. This angle of repose shall extend vertically six (6) feet below the lowest pond level. They shall be covered with topsoil and vegetated to deter erosion. Topsoil placement and

seeding must be done after spring runoff, but before September 1st. If composted material is to be used, you must notify this office before proceeding.

You must place topsoil, prepare the seedbed, fertilize and seed according to the guidelines specified in your Eau Claire County Nonmetallic Mine Permit Application.

All piles of material must be leveled or removed from the site upon completion of the project.

Removal of vegetative cover and the amount of exposed earth must be kept to a minimum and be consistent with good construction practices. Temporary erosion control measures must be employed as necessary to minimize sediment loss from the project site. Exposed areas must be sodded, or seeded and mulched as soon as possible to develop vegetative cover. If necessary, exposed areas must be watered to prevent the generation of excessive dust.

The Department retains continuing jurisdiction in this matter and may enact other requirements as necessary to ensure the prevention of environmental pollution.

Unless permitted under State and/or Federal authority, no solid or hazardous waste shall be store, buried, or deposited in or on this nonmetallic mining site.
