Hearing Information

- If you need to play an audio or video recording during an evidentiary hearing, you must call to make arrangements at least 48 hours prior to your hearing in order to test your laptop in the courtroom at 715-839-4818.

Requesting a Transcript

Find the name of the court reporter who transcribed the testimony by viewing the electronic case file. Contact the court reporter directly to make arrangements to pay for the transcript. The clerk of circuit court is not required to contact the court reporter for you. Contact information for court reporters is available on the <u>Circuit Court Directory</u>. If the court reporter has retired, you will need to contact <u>Chris Channing</u>, <u>District Court Administrator</u> for the 10th Judicial District.

New Courtroom Update

The construction of the new courtroom is complete and installation of the Digital Audio Recorder will take place the week of December 6, 2021. There have been delays in delivery of the furniture and chairs due to supply chain issues. Once received and the courtroom is completed, Judge Jon Theisen will relocate to the new courtroom and office space. Additional shifting may take place, and the Branch 6 Judge will occupy the remaining courtroom and office space.
