Attorney McIlquham Biography

Since 2001, Sharon Gibbs McIlquham has served as Assistant Corporation Counsel for Eau Claire County, in which she has been responsible for prosecuting child abuse and neglect cases while also handling guardianships and protective placements, mental health commitments, paternity, child support, zoning and real estate matters. McIlquham has a long record of community service, currently serving on the Chippewa Falls School Board and serving on the Lafayette Town Board since 2005. McIlquham has taught criminal, juvenile, and constitutional law to Criminal Justice and Law Enforcement Academy students at Chippewa Valley Technical College.



Through her professional work, McIlquham has been involved with the Drug Endangered Children Initiative, the Substance-free Pregnancy and Recovery Coalition, the Child Advocacy Center Multi-Disciplinary Team, the Child Death Review Team, and the Juvenile Justice Collaborating Council. McIlquham has served on boards for the Western Wisconsin Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation -serving as chair for the Walk to Cure Diabetes in Eau Claire for 14 years, Master Singers, and the Eau Claire Children's Theatre.
