Minutes from the December 7, 2021 meeting were approved without exception.

Tiana Glenna began the team's review of the mental health work underway in several different departments, including discussion of the Community Collaboration and Intervention group.

The team discussed upcoming staffing changes as they pertain to mental health processes, and how different departments are working together to facilitate constructive dialogue and find new avenues for collaboration.

The team also discussed how data analytics within the county have impacted mental health work, and what improvements can be made going forward to ensure continuity and better assist departments with their work.
