- 1. Meeting called to order by Chair Dunning at 2:02 p.m. Meeting confirmed.
- 2. Roll Call
- 3. Review/Approval of Past Minutes of the March 14th, 2022, meeting reviewed and approved. Motion to accept minutes Supervisor Gatlin, 2nd by Supervisor Sisk. Motion carried 3-0.
- 4. Public Comment No comment
- 5. Construction Schedule Update Kevin Dallas responded, currently working on main building underground plumbing and electrical, buried geo therm. Exterior brick is going up. Precast the week of May 16th. Steel for Meals on Wheels is on site. All components are on site for the cold storage. There is an issue with main electrical switch gear. Lead time is 52 weeks from Square D which would mean building would be complete but there would be no electricity. Heating the new building from time of completion to the 52-week lead time schedule would cost approximately \$150,000. There is a company called AMP from Minnesota, there would be an upcharge of \$50,000 with a 30–35-week lead time. Matt responded that he and Jon met with Kevin and decided to go ahead with AMP. A change order will be issued.
- **6. Owner Purchased Items Update** Matt referred to attached owner item sheet with cost. This included Truck Wash System and Vehicle Lifts.

Truck Wash System – Cost of \$239,329 and budget was \$225,000 Vehicle Lifts - Cost of \$175,116, and budget was \$136,000

Greg Bowe an example regarding price increases, a project was bid in 2019 and again in 2022 with an increase of about 42%. This is an example of what

is happening in the market.

Motion to approve Supervisor Gatlin, 2nd Supervisor Sisk. Motion carried 3-0.

7. Financial Update – Kevin responded low voltage cost firmed up. Overall project budget is still at \$32.7 million. Still have not used any contingency funds.

Next meeting should have pricing on Shelving, Office Furnishings and Equipment.

Smaller items yet to be priced, include Fiber, & Utility connections.

Norb asked, when can we expect funding from the state? As soon as we have costs confirmed, possibly submit paperwork in July to DOT.

Focus on Energy rebate of \$147,000 will probably be received sometime next spring.

Jon asked Kevin about final cost of Charging Stations, Kevin do you have cost? Grant is federal funds through DOT, and we need a confirmed cost. Kevin will follow up.

- 8. Appraisal for Property along USH 53 Jon gave background on said property. The property was appraised a couple of years ago and reappraised again earlier this year. Owner is willing to sell for \$325,000. Buildings to be raised about \$45,000 our cost. Money is not in the current budget for buying this property, but Jon stated that at some point we will probably purchase this property. It could be used for training. EV charging site could be possible. Property is in the town of Washington, and Highway facility is in city limits. Supervisor Dunning asked that we keep checking on status of this property. Supervisor Dunning also stated that property could possibly be an area for storage of Sheriff's vehicles. No action currently taken.
