Health Department staff shared basic background on community septic systems. Coffey shared information about concerns that have been raised about community septic systems regarding longevity, maintenance, assurance in the

case of failure. One community system is in place in the Trilogy development in Eau Claire County. Example policies for community systems exist from La Crosse and Waukesha.
