# FACT SHEET File No. 22-23/056

The 2022 Adopted Budget included Capital expenditures of \$9.261M for non-Highway building items to be funded through the issuance of General Obligation (GO) debt. The approved capital expenditures funded by the GO debt included the following:

Once the 2022 budget had been adopted, departments began exact on capital projects that had been approved. Historically, the county funds capital projects designate has to be funded by debt by using cash reserves during the year and replenishes these functhrough the proceeds of the debt issuance later in the year. As of September, ~\$6M of the bove noted projects had either been spent or financially committed.

At the time the 2022 budget was adopted, the plan for use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds had not been finalized.
