

Minutes for Board of Canvas - April 12, 2021 For the Spring Election held April 6, 2021

Monday, April 12, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.
Eau Claire County Courthouse, Room 1273

At 9:00 a.m. the Board of Canvas convened with Pamela Hicks, a Democrat, Carol Cox, a Republican and County Clerk Sue McDonald present to canvas the results from the April 6, 2021 Spring Election. Nick Koerner from the City of Eau Claire Elections office was also present.

County Clerk Sue McDonald administered the oath of office to the Board of Canvas member Pamela Hicks.

The two races being canvassed were the State Superintendent of Public Instruction and the District 3 Court of Appeals judge. All reporting information was present. A tabular report for the races was given to each canvas member. This report was used to confirm correctness when comparing each reporting unit's inspector's statement signed by poll workers with the individual results tapes from election night.

The total voters from the Inspectors' Statement was compared to the total vote counts per reporting unit for the top race, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, to make sure there was no unusual drop off of voters to ballots cast. It was noted that there were some important contested local races that would have drawn out voters for that race who may not have voted the Superintendent race. County Clerk Sue McDonald read the individual tape for each reporting unit and Pam Hicks and Carol Cox compared that number to their tabular report totals. Carol Cox compared the number to the Inspector's statement.

The following is information for each reporting unit of voters listed on the Inspectors Statement and actual ballots cast into machine. Where there is an asterisk there is a difference in the totals with an explanation of why that is:

No changes were made to that so a completed/verified report was printed from the Wisconsin Elections Canvas Report system and signed by the board. The county clerk e-mailed and sent copies of the signed reports USPS to the Wisconsin Elections Commission on April 13, 2021.
