Minutes for Board of Canvass April 14, 2020 For the Spring Election and Presidential Primary, April 7, 2020 Eau Claire County Courthouse Room 3312 10:00 a.m.

At 10:00 a.m. the Board of Canvass Pamela Hicks, a Democrat, Carol Cox, a Republican and County Clerk Janet Loomis were present to canvas the results from the April 7, 2020 Spring Election and Presidential Primary.

There were no observers.

All reporting information was present. A tabular report for the races of President of the United States, Democratic and Republican candidates, Justice of the Supreme Court, Circuit Court Judge Branch, Statewide Referendum, Chippewa Valley Technical College Referendum and 29 Districts for Eau Claire County Board of Supervisors was given to each canvas member. This report was used to confirm correctness when comparing each reporting unit's signed by poll workers individual results tapes from election night.

The total voters from the Inspectors' Statement was compared to the total vote counts per reporting unit for the Justice of the Supreme Court to make sure there was no great drop off of votes to voters. County Clerk Janet Loomis read the individual tape for each reporting unit and Pamela Hicks and Carol Cox compared that number to their canvas report totals.

The following is information when there was a difference between the number of voters listed on the Inspectors Statement and the number of ballots:

?Town of Washington Inspectors Statement stated 854 ballots and 853 voters. On election night the poll workers counted ballots and double checked the e-poll book and did a draw down from the ballots to match the voter list. The results of the draw down was one vote subtracted from Jill J. Karofsky. The poll workers changed to total tape to reflect that change.

The board of canvas did accept the numbers as presented by Washington.

The following wards vote at the same voting site and there was one voter who got the wrong ballot but all voters in Eau Claire County had the races that we canvassed with the exception that the County Board Supervisory District may be different depending on which ward, the following is information from the Inspector Statement:

Per the inspector's statement for Ward 60:

They stated that they did not have any voters for Ward 60 but because the did not have any ballots for Ward 45 (all the same races were on both ballots) they gave the voters the ballot style for Ward 60 They instructed the voters to place the ballot in the auxiliary bin but 2 voters placed them in the DS200 and were counted so the inspectors statement stated that we should subtract the votes cast for Ward 60 because there were no voters that voted in Ward 60. Once the received ballots the poll workers remade the Ward 60 ballots that were issued on the Ward 45 ballots and placed in the DS200 to be counted.

The following changes are what the board of canvas made due to 2 ballots being placed in the DS200 to be counted but later were remade and counted for the Ward 45:

There was a registered write-in candidate for Presidential Preference – Republican his name was Adam Nicholas Paul. The board of canvas reviewed the write-in tally sheets and recorded for him in the Town of Brunswick 1 vote, and the Town of Seymour 1 vote.

The board of canvas did not change any results report so a completed/verified report was printed from the Wisconsin Elections Canvas report, signed by the board. The county clerk e-mailed and sent USPS to the Wisconsin Elections Commission on April 14, 2020.
