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- THE APPLICANT WILL, AT APPLICANT'S EXPENSE, COMPLETE PERMITTED WORK WITHIN THE PRESENT HIGHWAY TO RIGHT-OF-WAY.
- The Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Permitting Authority, its Employees, and ties agents, from any cost, claim, suit, liability and/or award which might come, be brought, or be assessed because of the issuance or exercise of this permit, or because of any adverse effect upon any person or property, which is attributed to the partially or entirely completed works of the Applicant. Accomplishment of the permitted work, or any part thereof, by or on behalf of the Applicant shall bind such Applicant to abide by this permit and all conditions and provisions.
- The permitted facilities shall, if necessary, be altered at the expense of the applicant to permit alteration, improvement, or maintenance of the highway as may hereafter be ordered. The entire cost of constructing and maintaining the permitted facilities shall be the obligation of the Applicant unless a contract for such cost has been executed.
- No open cutting for a crossing will be allowed unless the Permitting Authority has specifically granted permission for such work. The pavement base course, sub-base and subgrade removed for a road crossing shall be replaced as per the Permitting Authority specifications.
- No one way traffic or detour will be allowed until the Eau Claire County Highway Department has approved a detailed one-way traffic or detour plan prepared by the Applicant.
- When working within the shoulder area or staging equipment of supplies along the road shoulder, the Applicant shall provide all necessary signs required by the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Plan (MUTCD).
- All disturbed areas shall be returned to their present condition or better, subject to the satisfaction of the Permitting Authority or its representative. Erosion control shall be implemented in accordance with Wisconsin DNR Best Management Practices. Access to all private drives and public streets intersections shall be maintained, and all disturbed areas completely restored.
- Any trench, tunneling, or excavating shall be performed in accordance with the requirements of OSHA and Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, and any applicable local regulations.
- A copy of this approval, along with any plans and special provisions, shall be available on the job site.
- Upon completion of the work, the Applicant shall file a written notice with the Permitting Authority.
- ALL above ground pedestals boxes, etc. associated with underground installations shall have a visible marker attached extending a minimum of four feet (4') above the highest point on the structure above ground
- The Applicant shall inform the Permitting Authority prior to removing any road signs. All regulatory and warning signs must be reinstalled at least temporarily by the end of each working day. Final reinstalled signs must be a minimum of 10' from any utility and at the MUTCD recommended height and distance from the edge of pavement.
- Vertical clearances for overhead utility facilities shall comply with all applicable state and national electrical codes. In all cases, facilities crossing over the highway shall at no time be less than 17 feet above the high point of the traveled way.
