LAND USE PERMITS ARE REQUIRED FOR:

- Any building or structure is erected, moved or structurally altered
- Any use of a building, structure or land is changed to another use, including the development or use of vacant land.

"Structure" means any manmade object with form, shape and utility, either permanently or temporarily attached to, placed upon or set into the ground, stream bed or lake bed, including, but not limited to, roofed and walled buildings, gas or liquid storage tanks, bridges, dams and culverts.

"Structural alteration" means any change in the supporting members of a building such as bearing walls, columns, rafters, beams, girders, footings and piles.
