E-filing Proposed Orders

When filing stipulations or motions with proposed orders, please indicate exactly what is to be ordered **on the proposed order**. Please do not indicate in the proposed order "IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the terms set forth in the attached motion/outlined in the stipulation are granted". These documents do not remain electronically "attached" and if the proposed order is not signed timely, it can be difficult to determine which motion or stipulation the Order references. It is also beneficial for the clerk (and anyone in general) to know exactly what is ordered sealed, redacted, removed, added, etc. Copy and paste the language from the motion/stipulation to the proposed order if you see fit, but ideally the order should be able to stand alone.
