Re: March 2023 - 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2023 Financial Report

It is extremely challenging to assess the fiscal performance for the first quarter of every year. At best, we can compare results to those of the previous year for comparative analysis and look for concerning early trends. Given expenditures always precede revenues further complicates the analysis.

#### **High-Level Fund Analysis**

From a first quarter perspective, the general fund generated a net year to date (YTD) deficit of \$2.2M which was \$.4M (18%) greater than the first quarter of 2022, although relatively flat as a percentage of budget YTY. Most general fund departments generated a surplus during the first quarter, although notable was a YTY increases in IS expenditures under contracted services due to shifting of costs from capital to operations as the county continues to migrate to cloud-based software services.

Other funds with significant year-to-year (YTY) changes included Highway, and Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC). The Highway department had increased expenditure activity in the first quarter compared to last year primarily related to construction of the new facility. The variance for ADRC YTY was driven by the timing of a grant receipt that was not received in the first quarter of 2023, but was in the first quarter of 2022.

### **County-wide Revenue**

From a county-wide overall perspective, excluding internal service fund (ISF) activity, 17.58% of the 2023 annual revenue budget has been recognized through March 31, 2023, as shown in the table below. This is slightly ahead of the revenue recognized at this same time last year of 16.85%.

Other taxes YTY in the first quarter is down \$.2M (~38%) driven by a shift in the classification of Shared Revenue from other taxes in 2022 to grants and aids in 2023 to align with state reporting.

Public charges for services resulted in being slightly behind 2022 collections due to decreased park fee receipts in the first quarter as compared to one year ago.

The most significant change from Q1'22 to Q1'23 is related to investment income which is recorded under Other Revenue. Due to rising interest rates, the county has been able to collect approximately 76.4% of the annual investment income budget in just the first quarter of 2023. Expectations are that interest income for 2023 will continue to exceed the adopted budget amount.

Specific components of revenue that can provide valuable information about the financial state of the county include sales tax collections, property tax collections, the vehicle registration fee, and several specific economic indicators. Each of these is reviewed in the following sections.

### **Property Taxes**

Relevant to the first quarter, property taxes are due on January 31 and are collected through that date. After January 31, all collections become the responsibility of Eau Claire County. Outstanding taxes as of March 31, 2023, are presented below and in comparison, to one year ago. As noted in the table, the absolute amount of uncollected taxes as of March 31,2023 is approximately 5.5% (\$2.1M) higher than that from one year ago, although the relative percentage of uncollected taxes to the total YTY is essentially flat. This could be an early indication of the tightening of the local economy, although the actual number of delinquent tax notices mailed after the first installment date was relatively flat to last year (~1,900), but with higher property tax values.

### Sales Tax

With the two-month lag in receipt of Sales Tax collections, the amount for the first quarter of 2023 is limited to just January, and thus doesn't provide much guidance. The January collection was ~ \$28K lower than the January collection in 2022. The county will continue to monitor this area closely as the year progresses. ### **Vehicle Registration Fee (VRF)**

The chart below outlines the VRF activity for the first quarter of 2023. Like sales tax, receipt of the VRF lags the month of collection, although only by one month and with much less volatility. For the first two months of 2023, Eau Claire County is slightly behind collections from a year ago. #### **Economic Indicators**

The local state of the economy is an important leading indicator of potential impact to Eau Claire County, which is monitored through key metrics including property tax collections, planning/zoning permits, register of deeds collections, and interest earned on invested funds. The key metrics being monitored are summarized in the table below. Interest/penalties collected on delinquent taxes YTY was up, possibly due to the continued assistance provided by the State through the Help for Homeowners program. Through the first quarter of 2023, the county has seen a decrease over Q1' 2022 in the amount of deed filing fees resulting from slowing activity in the housing and commercial market. Conversely, interest earned on investments has increased as a result of the rising interest rates.

Another key metric to consider is the local unemployment rate. The unemployment rate for Eau Claire County was 2.5% for March 2023. This is 0.2% lower than it was in March 2022. The national average for unemployment in March 2023 was 3.5%.

In addition, it is important to track the relative measure of inflation for the area, especially given its potential impact on sales tax collections. The Midwest region Consumer Price Index (CPI) based on the last 12 months for March 2023 was a 4.9% increase. This is in comparison to the 12-month rate in January 2023 of 6.0% and to the same period in 2022 which was 8.2%.

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### **Expenditures by Function**

A summary of the expenditures by function, excluding debt service and internal service fund activity, is shown below and provides a functional perspective of the expenditures in relationship to the budget. All county departments fall into one or more of the functional areas listed below. Capital Outlay below only includes projects funded by bond proceeds or American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. Equipment expenditures funded by other than bond proceeds are classified under the functional category that the purchase pertains to. Analysis of the functional expenditures can provide some insight into the demands of the community and the resulting expenditures incurred.

Functional expenditures through the first quarter of 2023 amounted to \$23.9 million (19.77%) as compared to \$19.4M (12.52%) in the first quarter of 2022. Most of the functional categories of expenditure through the first quarter are comparable to one year ago. The overall variance is largely due to increased expenditures in the transportation & public works program areas resulting from installment payments on the construction of the new highway facility.

### **Selected Expenditures by Category**

The largest expenditure category for the county is, and will continue to be, personnel costs. For the first quarter, personnel expenditures are expected to be ~19% based on the payroll processing lag. Personnel costs at the end of Q1 2023 are slightly below this target percentage primarily due to vacant FTE positions. At the end of March 2023, the county had 22 FTE vacant positions. For additional information on personnel costs please see the accompanying Trended Personnel Report.

Contracted services for the first quarter of 2023 increased ~\$360K from the first quarter of 2022. Most of this increase was driven by the increased shift in IS contracting services to the cloud-based vendors as noted earlier.

### **CONCLUSION**

Overall, given the very limited financial data for the first quarter of 2023, the county is slightly behind that of the first quarter of 2022. Relative to the percentage of the budget YTY, revenues and expenditures are in-line with historical expectations and for the most part comparable to those experienced in the first quarter of 2022. We are seeing some decline in the economic indicators in the first quarter, but we continue to experience low unemployment and realize the benefits of higher interest income. The most significant economic indicator for the county to keep an eye on is inflation and the potential impact it may have on sales tax collections. Given the sheer lack of data, it is impossible to draw any meaningful conclusions based on only the first quarter of data.
