# 1) Call to Order by Chair

Chair Koziel called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

#### 2) Roll Call

Roll call was taken. A quorum was present with 7 members.

## 3) Confirmation of Compliance with Open Meetings Law

Koziel confirmed that the open meeting requirements had been complied with.

# 4) Public Comment Period

No public comments.

# 5) Approval of the December 7, 2022, meeting minutes.

**ACTION**: Motion by Stelljes, second by Carlson to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried on a voice vote, 7-0-0.

6) Review Mathy/Ayres donation recommendation as proposed by the Land Donation Special Committee

**DISCUSSION:** Koziel opened the floor to Jolivette who is chair of the Land Donation Special Committee. Jolivette discussed how and why the Land Donation Special Committee came up with their recommendations. Roth aided the conversation using the map of the property displayed at the front of the room. Discussion on the importance of access and an H&H study being completed by Eau Claire County Parks and Forest Department was emphasized by the Land Stewardship Committee. The highest importance was given to access and then the H&H study second.

Pedersen left the meeting. (12:28 pm)

**ACTION:** Motion by Stelljes to take the Land Donation Special Committee whole recommendation, name of property, and packet to the Land Conservation Commission, with the next steps for Eau Claire County Parks and Recreation Department to seek access from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and to budget an H&H study for next year. Motion carried on a voice vote, 7-0-0.

## 7) Make a recommendation to dissolve the Land Donation Special Committee

**DISCUSSION**: Upon discussion, the Land Stewardship Committee decided to hold off on dissolving the Land Donation Special committee in case there was more work needed of the Special Committee.

**ACTION**: Motion by Koziel, second by Stelljes to approve dissolving the Land Donation Special Committee to the Land Conservation Commission. Motion carried on a voice vote, 7-0-0.

## 8) Update of airport mitigation fund

**DISCUSSION:** Koziel started the discussion seeking background information on the funds. Knight gave a brief overview of the mitigation fund. Next, Stelljes provided an in depth look at the airport mitigation funds along with additional information from DeLuka. The Land Stewardship committee now has \$20,000 of airport mitigation funds in their account to use.

# 9) Discussion of past and potential projects

**DISCUSSION:** A potential property for a preservation/conservation easement along Lowes creek was discussed by Koziel. Stelljes brought up acquiring the sand mine property near Harstad park.

**DISCUSSION:** Terms for its members were reviewed by the subcommittee. Jolivette and Dressel terms are set to expire April of 2023 and they would like to remain on the committee.

**Action:** Motion by Stelljes to bring reappointment of Jolivette and Dressel to Land Conservation Commission. Motion carried on a voice vote, 7-0-0.

# <u>Call to Order Committee on Parks & Forest and confirmation of meeting notice</u>

Chairman Knight called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and confirmed public posting of the meeting.

#### **Public Comment**

No members of the public wished to make a comment.

# Review of May 8, 2023, Committee Meeting Minutes

Supervisor Schraufnagel moved to approve the minutes from May 8, 2023. All in favor.

#### Resolution 23-24.018 Withdrawal of County Forest Land

Mike Lea has requested the withdrawal of two (2) proposed sand spoil sites adjacent to one another, about 9.94 acres from the Eau Claire County Forest Program. After approval from the Committee on Parks and Forest, further approval will be needed from the County Board and then from the Department of Natural Resources. This site was chosen because of its close proximity to the sand traps near the boat landing on the Eau Claire River, which feeds into Lake Eau Claire and because of the low timber quantity and quality on these sites. These traps and sand spoil sites are necessary to keep the boat landings safe and open. Supervisor Zook moved to approve Resolution 23-24/018 as written. All in favor, none opposed.

# <u>Light Up the Woods request at Lowes Creek Park</u>

Nick Meyer from CORBA requested permission from the Committee on Parks and Forest to host a CORBA Fundraiser called "Light Up the Woods." This fundraiser would involve lighting and projected lighting throughout the trails at Lowes Creek Park. Along the trails there would also be beer tents whereby the beverages would be included in the sale of tickets. Supervisor Zook moved to postpone action on this request until the July 10, 2023, Committee Meeting to allow County Corporate Legal Counsel to review the request and approve the specific details, especially regarding the presence and handling of alcoholic beverages. All in favor, none opposed.

# Coon Fork 40 Bike Event

Nick Meyer, from CORBA presented the proposal to host a fundraiser gravel bike riding event to start and finish at the Coon Fork beach side. Gravel events such as these are gaining popularity and work for all

types of bikes. The monies raised from this event would be used to maintain the already established trails and develop new trails. Supervisor Schraufnagel moved to approve the Coon Fork 40 Bike Fundraiser Event pending review from County Corporate Legal Counsel. All in favor, none opposed.

# Jeremy Doro Land Sale

Landowner, Jeremy Doro, is interested in selling a 40-acre parcel of land that butts up to county property. This parcel consists mainly of white pine, which would not likely be logged. Access is from the north and has a gated easement. Supervisor Schraufnagel moved to forward the proposal to the Land Stewardship Department for their review and to see if there are grants available to allow for price matching. All in favor, none opposed.
