the equipment. Some funding sources
include: Medicare, Medicaid, WisLoan,
or public and/or agency funding
programs.

Options Counselors are available to assist you with determining what adaptive equipment may help you to remain safe and independent in your home. Appointments can be scheduled in the office or in your own home.

Where does my contribution go?

The contribution amount is deposited into the Aging & Disability Resource Center Equipment Program fund.

As funding allows, new items for the loan program will be purchased
