

## What if I need to use Adaptive Equipment long term (more than 3 months)

Aging & Disability Resource Center Options Counselors can talk with you if you have a long term need for Adaptive Equipment. They can help you identify which items you need and where the items are available to purchase.

In addition, they can help you determine if there are any resources available to pay for the equipment. Some funding sources include: Medicare, Medicaid, WisLoan, or public and/or agency funding programs.

### Not sure what you need?

Options Counselors are available to assist you with determining what adaptive equipment may help you to remain safe and independent in your home. Appointments can be scheduled in the office or in your own home.



## Where does my contribution go?

The contribution amount is deposited into the Aging & Disability Resource Center Equipment Program fund.

As funding allows, new items for the loan program will be purchased
