



The Wisconsin Statute 59.10 (3) and the county code 1.08.001 (B) allow for the change in county board supervisor district boundaries due to annexations with county board action. This resolution incorporates new ward numbers and boundary changes due to annexations since the county board adopted resolution 21-22/066 on November 9, 2021. This resolution should be passed prior to county board supervisors' circulation of nomination papers on December 1. This resolution is needed for election purposes and there is no fiscal impact.
