The structure, oversight, and policy of the Eau Claire County Junior Fair has historically been governed by Eau Claire County as currently required by County Code. The Committee on UW-Extension Education is the standing supervising committee for the Fair Committee. The Fair Committee is a working committee for fair policy and volunteers. The Friends of the Fair (FOF) is a private 501(C)(3) created to solicit funds, collect donations, pay contracts, and submit financials to Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection (DATCP) for youth premium pay outs. There are also 4-H volunteers, the Livestock Committee, and UW-Extension Madison that have varying roles in the execution of the Eau Claire County Junior Fair.

It is understood that there are only two counties in the State to have such a structure. The vast number of entities involved in this structure inherently leads to conflict. The parties wish to have one cohesive decision-making body that is not confined by County requirements like walking quorums, conflicts of interest, and open meeting laws. For example, Fair Committee members are not allowed to serve as supervisory roles for other fair entities, like FOF, due to County Code requirements related to conflicts of interest. By its very nature, this leads to possible communication issues, silos of information, and responsibility. Moreover, some parents are reluctant to enroll their children in programs where they are required to give notice to the general public. The structure and these issues are believed to have contributed to a drop in fair members/volunteers.

The current proposal moving forward after the 2024 fair, is to take leadership from FOF and the Fair Committee and combine these individuals into a new a Fair Board, Agricultural Society or Agricultural Association. The newly combined decision-making board would benefit from all parties being present when decisions are made, whether the issue is policy, governance, or fundraising. The number of required meetings would be reduced by half and many issues that currently are heard at multiple meeting only need to be noticed for one meeting. It is hoped that the volunteer numbers would increase with a structure in place that brings all parties to the table and is less demanding of time.

It is anticipated that this newly combined decision-making board would be formed under the FOF 501(C)(3) status. If allowed, the Office of Corporation Counsel can assist in the transition process and provide guidance complying with DATCP regulations and creating bylaws.

Once the 2024 fair is complete, the newly combined decision-making board is established, and the bylaws are complete, the role of the Office of Corporation Counsel would be limited to representing the Parks and Forest Department in fair matters moving forward.

The fair would return to requesting funds like any other community agency in the County. The County role with the fair would be one of lessor/lessee. The County would no longer be responsible for the fair, but would provide support through funding a community organization, and providing the location per the lease. There may also be an opportunity for a County Board member to serve as a liaison for the fair.

Fiscal Impact: Substantially less in-kind funds will be expended on the Fair.

County Ordinance 2.04.450 defines the responsibility of the Committee on UW-Extension education. This amendment removes the requirement for the Committee on UW-Extension education, thus the County, to be the entity responsible for policy and oversight of the Eau Claire County Fair.

Secondly, the County Administrator and UW Wisconsin-Madison Extension have requested to rename UW-Extension Education Committee to the <u>Community Outreach and Education</u> <u>Committee</u> in order to reduce confusion between the entities. Sections 2.04.120, 2.04.450, and 17.02.010 are included to reflect the name change.

Fiscal Impact: Minimal costs related to publishing the new name.
