

Minutes for Board of Canvassers - April 8, 2024 For the Spring Election & Presidential Preference – April 2, 2024

Monday, April 8, 2024
Eau Claire County Courthouse, Room 1273

At 9:00 a.m. on Monday, April 8, 2024, the Election Board of Canvassers convened with Chris Howard, a Democrat, Nancy Erickson, a Republican, and County Clerk Sue McDonald present to canvass the results from the April 2, 2024 Spring Election & Presidential Preference.

The races being canvassed were for Partisan Presidential Preference- Democrats & Republicans, Eau Claire County Circuit Court judges for Branches 3, 4 & 5, Eau Claire County Supervisory Districts 1-29, and two State of Wisconsin referendum questions relating to the use of private funds in election administration and election officials. All reporting information was present. A tabular report for the races was given to each canvas member. This report was used to confirm accuracy when comparing each reporting unit’s Inspector’s statement signed by poll workers with the transmitted results and individual results tapes from election night.

The total voter count from the Inspectors’ Statement of each municipality and ward was compared to the total vote counts per reporting unit. County Clerk Sue McDonald read the individual tape for each reporting unit and Chris Howard and Nancy Erickson compared that number to their tabular report totals. Nancy Erickson compared the number to the Inspector’s statement.

The following is a comparison of the number of voters listed on the Inspectors Statement and actual ballots cast into the machine for each reporting unit. The notes show if there is a difference in the totals with an explanation of why that is if it could be determined:

The following registered write-in candidate received the following votes:

Eau Claire County Supervisory District 1: Todd Meyer 129 votes (including +1 from City of Augusta where voter did not fill in oval so machine did not tally.)

The following adjustment was made due to a ballot that had a write-in name filled in, but the oval was not filled in, so the machine did not tally in the Town of Washington.

President of the United States (Republican): Donald Trump + 1 vote

Upon completion of the canvas the changes were entered in the State Elections Commission canvass reporting system. A certified summary statement of the Board of Canvassers was printed and signed for the state races and the county races. The report was uploaded to the Election results page of the County website. The state report was sent by email and regular mail to the state of Wisconsin. A copy of the statement is attached to this report.
