2.04.200 Rule 20—Appointment of Standing Committees

- <u>A.</u> The chair with the 1st vice-chair and 2nd vice-chair shall make appointments to all standing committees of the board.
- B. The chair shall inform all county board members of vacancies that occur on standing or special committees, commissions or boards and solicit supervisors if they wish to be considered for appointment. The county board chair shall consult and receive recommendations from the 1st and 2nd vice-chairs before making appointments.
- C. County board supervisors shall not chair more than one of the standing committees.
- D. County Board Supervisors shall not be appointed to committees, boards, or commissions until the completion of the conflict of interest form is filed with the human resources department. The corporation counsel shall review the submitted forms and provide a report to the chair, 1st vice-chair and 2nd vice chair before making appointments.
