Provides members support services while engaging them in activities to become self-sufficient. Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA): No-cost program to assist eligible low-income adults, dislocated workers and youth re-enter the workforce. Wisconsin Works (W2): Cash payments depending on placement within W-2. Amount of payment depends on individual situations and W-2 participants are expected to participate in up to 40 hours of activity per week to include community service work, job search, workshops, job training or classes held at your local Job Center.
