The Honorable Michael A. Schumacher has announced his healthy retirement from the bench effective August 9, 2024. Judge Schumacher was born and raised in Hudson, Wisconsin. He practiced civil litigation from 1981 to 2007 with the Herrick and Hart law firm in Eau Claire. Governor Jim Doyle then appointed Judge Schumacher to preside over Eau Claire County Circuit Court Branch 2 following the passing of Judge Eric Wahl. He has served on and chaired many local and statewide committees and had the pleasure of presiding over drug treatment courts for a dozen years. Judge Schumacher has been the presiding administrative judge for Eau Claire County since the retirement of Judge William Gabler in 2018. Judge Schumacher feels blessed to have worked with exceptional judicial colleagues and court staff and will miss them sorely.
