Review of March 18, 2024, ADRC Board Minutes / Discussion – Action, Handout #1 - Sue Miller motioned to approve as presented. All approved. None opposed.

Recognized End of Board Terms

ADRC Board Membership / Discussion, Handout #2:

Reviewed the terms of the current board members.

85.21 Paratransit Funding Update:

Director Linda Struck informed the board that the Department of Transportation (DOT) has approved a onetime exception to have a dispersal from the 85.21 Trust Fund to cover the projected 2024 deficit. We are currently projecting a deficit of \$75,000 in the paratransit program.

Vehicle repair grant has awarded \$14,715 to eligible recipients, with approximate \$5,000 left in the grant.

2025-2027 Aging Plan Update, Handout #3:

Linda explained that a survey is currently open for the community to provide input that will be used in the upcoming 2025-2027 Aging Plan. Discussion was held about the survey.

Nutrition Updates:

March for Meals has ended with \$10,200 in donations. This is the largest year of donations in recent memory.

Stella recapped information shared at the recent Nutrition Advisory Council.

Advocacy/Unmet Needs:

Aging Advocacy Day – May 14, 2024, a charter bus will be leaving at 6 a.m. for board members who are interested in attending Advocacy Day in Madison. Stella led a discussion on accessibility issues encountered by individuals in the community. Bill explained that the 60" x 60" for public restrooms is a federal guideline, and that adherence to this guideline would make restrooms accessible for most types of mobility devices.

Linda informed the board that the ADRC is supporting an advocacy grant that the Eau Claire County/City Health Department is applying for that is to support coalitions that will target social connectiveness and livable communities.

Future Agenda Items:

May's ADRC Board meeting will be an organizational meeting, nomination of officers and clerk. Stella asked that on each future agenda include the following three topics as standard topics to be covered: Nutrition, Transportation, and the Resource Center.

Stella adjourned the meeting at 5 p.m.
