Helpful Jury Information

- Jury questionnaires may be requested by emailing EauClaire.Info@wicourts.gov.
- Jury questionnaires are available up to 2 business days prior to the first day of the trial.
- Jury panel lists are not available until 2 business days prior to the first day of the trial.
- In the event of multiple trials scheduled throughout the 2-week panel, jurors may be called to report to more than one case. For this reason, when multiple cases are held in one day and another trial is scheduled to begin the following day, the list may not be available until the day prior to the trial after Voir Dire is complete.
- Wisconsin Statute 756.04(11)(a) states that “counsel and parties may not retain copies of the qualification forms or supplemental information obtained under sub. (6)(am) and sub (6)(cm).” Attorneys shall confidentially destroy list and questionnaires within 7 days of the conclusion of the jury trial or return them to the Clerk of Court for confidential destruction.
