Reminders to Attorneys

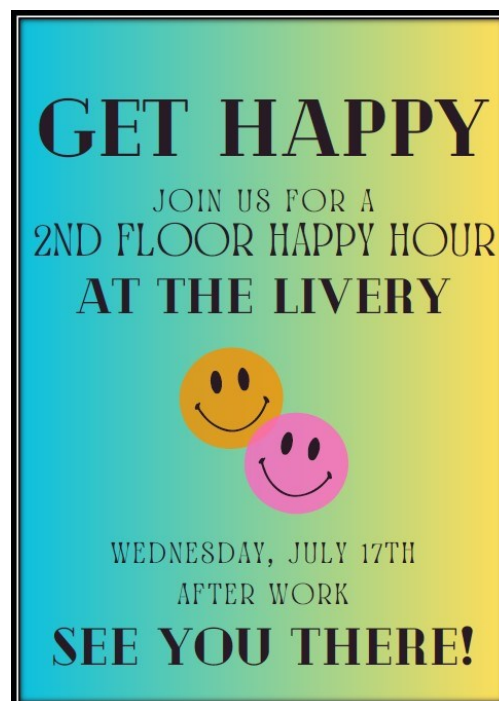
When you withdraw from representation of a defendant, you must withdraw from all cases. If you are receiving notices after that time, you are responsible to pass these along to the defendant.

Interesting Tidbits January 1-June 30, 2024

- Interpreter costs were \$30,953.88.
- Interpreters have been used for eleven different languages.
- Clerk of Court staff have added in excess of 125,000 documents.
- Court Appointed Attorney invoices processed/paid and assessed to cases = \$124,618.50.
- Court Appointed Attorney payments received from defendants regardless of age of assessment = \$85,926.45.
