

# Minutes for Board of Canvassers - August 19, 2024 For the August 13, 2024 Partisan Primary Election

Monday, August 19, 2024  
Eau Claire County Courthouse, Room 1301

At 9:00 a.m. on Monday, August 19, 2024, the Election Board of Canvassers convened with Chris Howard, a Democrat, Nancy Erickson, a Republican, and County Clerk Sue McDonald present to canvass the results from the August 13, 2024 Partisan Primary Election. Others present in the room were: Elizabeth Pettis, Town of Bridge Creek Clerk; Peggy Blomenberg, Town of Washington election inspector; Sarah Smith and Judy Dekan Town of Seymour election inspectors; Sherrie McCormick, Town of Lincoln Clerk; Kristina Kuzma, City of Eau Claire Clerk and Andrea Helland Eau Claire County Chief Deputy County Clerk.

The races being canvassed were United States Senator, Representative in Congress District 3, Representative to the Assembly Districts 91 and 93, County Clerk, County Treasurer, County Register of Deeds and two State of Wisconsin referendum questions. All reporting information was present. A tabular report for the races was given to each canvas member. This report was used to confirm accuracy when comparing each reporting unit's Inspector's statement signed by poll workers with the transmitted results and individual results tapes from election night.

Municipal clerks and/or election inspectors (as listed above) from the towns of Bridge Creek, Washington, Seymour, Lincoln and City of Eau Claire were present to review ballots and complete write-in tally sheets for races that had no candidates. Andrea Helland, Chief Deputy County Clerk, completed a sheet for the Town of Wilson. Ballot bags were opened and resealed in the presence of the County board of canvassers.

The total voter count from the Inspectors' Statement of each municipality and ward was compared to the total vote counts per reporting unit. County Clerk Sue McDonald read the individual signed machine tapes for each reporting unit, and Chris Howard and Nancy Erickson compared that number to their tabular report totals that were printed from the state elections database as reported on election night. Nancy Erickson compared the numbers to the Inspector's statements.

The following is a comparison of the number of voters listed on the Inspectors Statement and actual ballots cast into the machine for each reporting unit. The notes show if there is a difference in the totals with an explanation of why that is if it could be determined:




